Arizona has many limestone areas, parts of which are composed of usable rock for flux in smelters, for cement and for lime. In other parts the clastic ratio may be too high, or chert or clay lenses may be too prevalent. Most of the areas are in Carboniferous or Devonian limestone formations such as the Naco, Escabrosa, Redwall, Modoc, etc. They are located in the Chiricahua, Dragoon, Huachuca, Mule and Whetstone mountains in Cochise County; in the Empire, Rincon and Santa Catalina mountains in Pima County; in the Patagonia and Santa Rita mountains in Santa Cruz County; in the Dripping Springs and Tortilla mountains in Gila and Pinal Counties; in the Colorado Plateau Rim (Redwall Formation) from the New Mexico line to Lake Mead, in Apache, Coconino, Gila, Mohave, Navajo and Yavapai counties; in the Black Hills near Jerome; in the Grand Canyon and elsewhere in Arizona.

Dolomitic limestones or marbles are present near Cave Creek in Maricopa County; in the Harquahala mountains in Maricopa and Yuma Counties; and elsewhere.
