Arizona's copper production in 1958 is estimated at 50.0 percent of U.S. production.

The gross value of Arizona's copper production in 1958 dropped \$57 million from that of 1957, which in turn had dropped \$119.5 million from the all-time high copper production value of \$430 million in 1956.

Curtailment of copper production, begun in 1957, continued until August when the work-week was increased at some plants from four to five days. By the end of the year most plants had resumed a 5-day work-week, and a six-or seven-day production week.

Arizona is estimated to rank 4th in lead production and 5th in zinc production, among the Western States; 5th and 6th, respectively, in the U. S.
