For the first seven months of 1959, Arizona copper production was at a new record annual rate of 556,000 tons, but a 5-months strike which began Aug. 10th, hit most of the large copper producers, with the result that instead of attaining a production of 556,000 tons for the year, only an estimated 429,200 tons were produced; a loss of 126,800 tons due to the strike. The estimated average price of copper was 31.000 cts. per pound, as compared with a 1958 price of 25.764 cts.

Lead production dropped from 11,890 tons in 1958 to an estimated 9,800 tons in 1959. The estimated price for 1959 was 11.9 cts. as compared with 12.1 cts. in 1958.

Zinc production in Arizona rose from 28,532 tons in 1958 to an estimated 38,100 tons in 1959. The price rose from 10.31 cts. in 1958 to an estimated 11.4 cts. in 1959.
