Geology: The San Xavier thrust crosses center part of group, with a flat easterly dip. Western half underlain by Sierrita granite, and eastern half by Cretaceous(?) sedimentary-volcanic complex, consisting of arkose, quartzite, conglomerate, andesite, graywacke, etc. There would appear to be only a thin veneer of these rocks overlying the thrust.

There are numerous prospect bits, dozer cuts, etc., which expose minor shearing and thin quartz stringers. These generally strike East-West to S 80°W, with steep northerly dips. Considerable Mn and FeOX are associated with the quartz. Minor sulphides (pyrite?) were noted on dumps.

Recommendations: No further interest.
