<u>Present Mining Activity</u>: Diamond drilling by Joy Manufacturing Co., (Drilling Division) on contract, with 2 diamond drills working. The work in the Carpenter shaft was closed down as of today, and the men working for United Nuclear Corp., in the shaft, will be transferred to other operations in New Mexico. Diamond drilling from the surface will be continued.

Review of Recent Operations: Since last report, the following work has been done:

- (1) The two drifts on the 220 ft. level of the Carpenter shaft were repaired and retimbered.
- (2) Underground diamond drilling was done by Joy Manufacturing Co. on contract from the 220 ft. level. Mr. Hoskins reports that these drill holes were drilled to a depth of about 200 ft. This work was finished a few days ago.

(3) Most of the machinery and equipment in and around the shaft was removed. The head frame and the mine hoist was left in place. This might be removed later, according to Mr. Hoskins.

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### Present Mining Activity

(1) Diamond drilling by Joy Drilling Co. on contract, with 2 diamond drills wofking
(2) Repairing and retimbering the old Carpenter shaft and two drifts on the 220' level.
(3) Geological surveys, with 2 men working 12 men working 12 men working // 12 men working

### Review of Recent Operations

(1) Since last report, Joy Drilling Co. has been diamond drilling on the property with 2 diamond drills working two shifts each. 10 holes have now been completed, and 2 additional holes are now being drilled. Holes average about 1,000 ft. in depth. Most of the drilling has been in Sec. 26 - T 6 S - R 27 E, with some drilling also in sections 27 and 35. This is about 1 1/2 miles NW of the Gila River, and 2 miles NW of the old Clifton road.

(2) Retimbering and repairing the old Carpenter shaft has been continued the past two months, with 12 men working on 2 shifts. A steel head frame and a hoist was installed at the mine. The shaft was filled with muck **and example** up to the 171 ft. level, which was cleaned out, after which the shaft was retimbered where necessary. The shaft was finished up to a depth of 225 ft (the original bottom), after which repairing and retimbering of two drifts on the 220 ft. level was started, which is now in process.

(3) Geological surveys are still being continued, with 2 men working.

### Present Mining Activity:

(1) Diamond drilling by Joy Drilling Co. on contract with 2 diamond drills operating.

(2) Repairing & retimbering old shaft - 6 men working

(3) Geological surveys - 2 men working.

Old Mine Workings: 1 vertical shaft, 225 ft. deep, filled with water up to 171 ft. below the collar. This shaft has a 225 ft. level with a long drift from this level. It is reported to have been operated by a Mr. Carpenter during World War I, but there are no records of the operation.

### Review of Operations:

- (1) 8 diamond drill holes have been drilled to date.
- (2) Repairing & retimbering of the old shaft was started a few days ago. A hoist will be installed and a headframe erected in the next few days.

(3) Geological reconnaissance and mapping will also be continued.

Review of Recent Operations: Exploration work was started on the property on Sept. 15,1963, and diamond drilling was started about Oct. 15 by Joy Drilling Co. with 1 diamond drill operating. A second diamond drill was moved in about Jan. 23.

5 holes have been drilled to date, and the 6th hole is now being drilled. Most of the holes have been drilled to depths over 1,000 ft. and will average about 1,000 ft. Most of the cores are NX.

Subject: Nancy Group of Claims and 3 holes drilled by Cerro Corp during 1966 (Engineer visited area in 1965 (Dec.) and 1966)

The Nancy group of claims is shown on the accompaning map. This is the general area.

There are supposed to be 122 claims. During the past year the Cerro Corp. drilled three holes. One for 1700", one for 1500' and one for 2000'.

Cerro Corp. was looking for a large massive low grade area that might possibily exist in shattered andesite. The holes were rock bited for the first 1000' and then cored. Some low grade copper mineralization was found. Less than .03% An area of shattered andesite was not found.
