Work: The entry shaft is 60-65 feet deep and is equipped with a headframe, gasoline hoist and bucket. The placer has been stoped out from this shaft for a number of feet.

Al Applington states that the placer is screened and dry washed. He said the grade was good.

Geology: The other data is similar to the Applington placers except that the overburden is thicker and the lower bed is more conformative to the present drainage system, particularly as compared to the Applington South Placer.
