In a contact which has an andesite footwall a fault fissure vein about 8' wide carries lead, zinc & some fluorite. Development consists of a shallow 50' adit with an incline winze sunk from it & a 30' vertical shaft 15' S of portal adit. A mining engineer reported sampling the winze 12 yrs. ago & getting fairly good values over 8'. This information was reported to the USBM. An engineer attempted to make an examination but did not get down the winze.

Character of Ore:

Sulphides of lead & zinc. Fluorite occurs as gangue.


