Location: 5½ miles SE of Salome, and near the Salome-Buckeye Hwy.
(Approx. S-10, T 4 N, R 13 W)

Claims: 2 Unpatented claims which are part of the Del Monte block. ^{RIO} ^(file)
(Previously owned by O.K. Gilliam, now deceased).

Owner: Edna Eckels, Box 388, Salome, Arizona

Mineral: White "bull" quartz.

Work: Location pits.

Geology: According to Mrs. Eckels, a considerable blowout of bull quartz is present. The quartz carries no other known values. It is apparently in granitic rocks.

Comment: This property was referred to Del Petersen, general Mgr., U.S. Marble Co. who wants white quartz to market with his marble. Petersen will visit this soon. Due to the property's proximity to U.S. Marble's Mill (8 miles by paved highway), it could prove satisfactory to them provided the quartz is of the right kind. This quartz is opaque and white.
