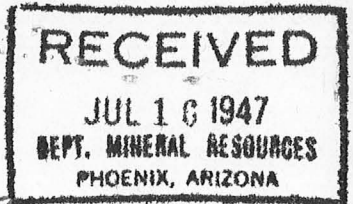

Subject: Examination

This property, consisting of 3 claims is held by Catalina Mineral Co., R.B. Hodgkins Gem Mgr, Box 32, Oracle. It is located 2 miles south of Oracle Jct. Oracle Hgwy. at Linda Vista Guest Ranch, about 4 miles west Oracle. It is believed that parts of each claim are located on state lands and owners are making survey in preparation for application for state lease.

Area comprises low rolling foothills ~~to~~ north of Catalinas opposite and just north of Canada del Oro. Prevailing rock is granite with occasional diorite and monzonite dykes trending generally east-west. Silver ledge claims are on granite diorite contact dipping slightly north with granite as foot wall. At surface high grade lead-silver ore found in brecciated contact zone. Shallow oxidized zone with sulfides coming in prominently at 45 feet, present depth of shaft. Here diorite is reeding and replaced monzonite porphyry coming in with contact gouge all of which shows good lead-silver values.
