MG WR 5/27/88: Visited the Simons Marble property (file) Pima County. There is no sign of recent activity on this property. It appears to consist of a relatively large area of outcropping limestone (Escabrosa?) that is locally marbalized.

MG WR 5/27/88: Visited the Empire Mtns. Group limestone (file) Pima County. I believe, after reviewing the physical location and the mine files, that the Empire Mtns Group limestone file should be merged into the Simons Marble file.

NOTES FROM ANAMAX FILES ON ESCABROSA LIMESTONE TESTS:

11/4/66: Colo.Sch.Mines Res. Found. Inc. R.S. Bruski

Comments: 5 samples. Suitable for conversion to quicklime for metallurgical use. Fractures excessively during crushing, and during firing in rotary kiln it disintegrates excessively.

Average analysis: 96%Ca as CaCO3, 2.5%Mg as MgCO3, R2O3 0.35%, Insol. 3.4%

2/15/67:


Comments: Little loss by blowout - no more than normal.

6/6/67: C.S.M.R.F.I.

Comments: Calcined in Calcimatic Kiln at Ash Grove Lime and Portland Cement Co. at Sprinfield, Mo. Lime yield = 59% of stone feed. Stone fast burning with normal fuel requirement. Minimum decrepitation with Calcimatic Kiln. Produced acceptable grade quicklime.

8/67: Kennedy Van Saun, Danville, Pa.

Comments: Limestone is not suitable for rotary kiln burning.
