The rock is full of openings or vugs stained by limonite and manganese dioxide. Mr. Thompson stated that it finds considerable use in landscaped gardens, for rock gardens, and for decorative walls. He also stated that there was diatomite, tuff, and volcanic flows in the area including probable ~~scoria~~ or cinders.
