5. Mineral applicant has failed to furnish the Department proof of a valuable mineral deposit on the area of application for Mineral Lease No. 11-78258.

6. Permittee admitted that he had cleared the areas referred to in Paragraph No. 3, above, for which the Department has determined the trespass damages, as single damages, are in the amount of \$18,000.00.
