Subject: Interview with Joe Scott

Location: 1 airline mile east of Rock House (approx. S. 28, T. 7 N., R. 15 E.)

Property: Spikehorn 1-5 claims, unpatented.

Owner: Joe Scott, 3013 N. 36th Drive, Phoenix.

Work: Two short tunnels are in about 40 feet.
1 bulldozer cut.

Geology: A narrow asbestos bed lies in the upper part of the lower member of the Mescal limestone in a serpentized zone below a diabase dike. Some of the fiber consists of a single seam 1 to $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches wide.

Note: Mr. Scott is trying to sell his claims, or is trying to interest someone in erecting a mill at Young or at Payson. It was pointed out that since he has largely No. 1 soft asbestos and little of the other grades, the marketing situation would be difficult. Secondly the narrowness of the asbestos bearing bed would present a costly mining problem because of the very large waste to ore ratio. His fiber specimens were mostly soft or semi-soft asbestos.

I am enclosing what information I have regarding the proof of annual labor on the mines that my brother owned.

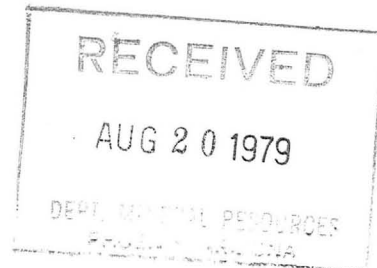

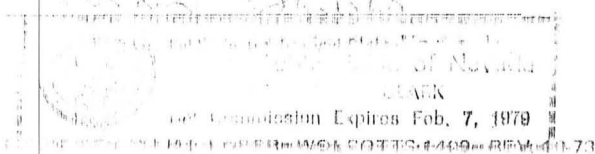

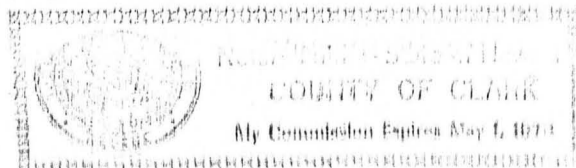
