SUBJECT: John B. Eckel Property, Chmpwood, Arizona

On March 9th I visited the John B. Eckel property near Campwood, Arizona. I was accompanied on this examination by Mr. Robert Passmore, a friend of Mr. Eckels.

This property is situated in the Campwood, Arizona District and the copper showings are located approximately in the center of the unpatented Stringtown #1 claim. This claim is located one and one-half miles northeast of the Campwood postoffice. Mr. Eckels has five unpatented claims in this area.

A quartz dike outcrops for approximately 100 feet and is bounded on the hanging wall by a micaceous schist and on the footwall by a granite. A couple of cuts werem mined, starting at the water level and extending to the quartz dike. A cut alongside the quartz dike was also mined. Very little mineralization whows and only a very few of the rocks on the dump show any copper staining. This outcrop has all the appearances of a blow-out and in my opinion not worthy of any interest to the company.
