HEM WR $^{\circ}8/6/88$: The Stroud Brothers Mine, Cochise County was visited. The property is sporadically mined for crushed decorative stone by a partnership including the Dragoon Topsoil Company. The rock is a brecciated, red hematite stained, pinkish marble mapped by Copper and Silver (1984) as Black Prince Limestone. Some manganese oxide staining is also present. The most colorful rock is found along a NNW fault zone but does not seem to be developed for any great width, perhaps 50-75 feet.
