Kingman, Arizona ----- A new vein four feet in width has been discovered in the Sunnyside mine, near Oatman, by Jack Brock and J. C. Cook, according to Elgin B. Holt, field engineer for the Department of Mineral Resources.

Holt states that this property has been under lease to Brock and Cook. They first sampled the dump and shipped 100 tons of ore that averaged about \$20.00 gold per ton. Then they did some sampling in the shaft, did some exploratory work, which resulted in opening up a goodly showing of ore. They then made some shipments that ran over \$60.00/ per ton, which was mined from a vein 4 feet wide. Also in another spot they have uncovered a 6-inch stringer that assays 49 ounces in gold, per J. H. Jones, of Oatman, who states: "They have found a peculiar type of ore that is new in this district that runs from 2 to 3 ounces in gold. It's entirely different from anything else here in camp. Quite a few of the old timers are talking about this discovery and somewhat excited about it."

The Sunnyside mine is located south of the Telluride property, or between the Telluride and the Iowa mine. A number of engineers have visited this new discovery and think well of it.
