The Sunny Slope was visited on May 31 with Mr A. W. Griems, the owner.

This property is located about 4 miles west of the town of Payson, and good roads to the property with the exception of the last half mile which has to be walked.

The property consists of one claim held by location and assessment work.

The formation is a granite-diorite with very small fissures cutting it. In the fissure, there are a few small lenses of white quartz carrying a small per cent of copper, (estimated about 2%). It is also claimed that a small gold and silver values are found.

There is very little work done and consists of a 4 X 4 shaft down 10 feet and a trench across the vein about 20 feet from the shaft.

The property is a prospect and it is very doubtful if ores would return the cost of digging for them.
