

The Fish and Wildlife Service is now proposing to delist the snail darter or, at the very least, take it out of endangered species status. It seems that the rare snail darter, upon search, has been found in a number of tributaries of the Tennessee River as well as the main stem. So it is no longer endangered, according to an advance notice in the Federal Register. This could be the first United States species delisted under the Endangered Species Act because of abundance.
