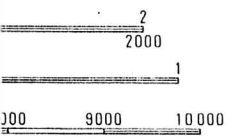
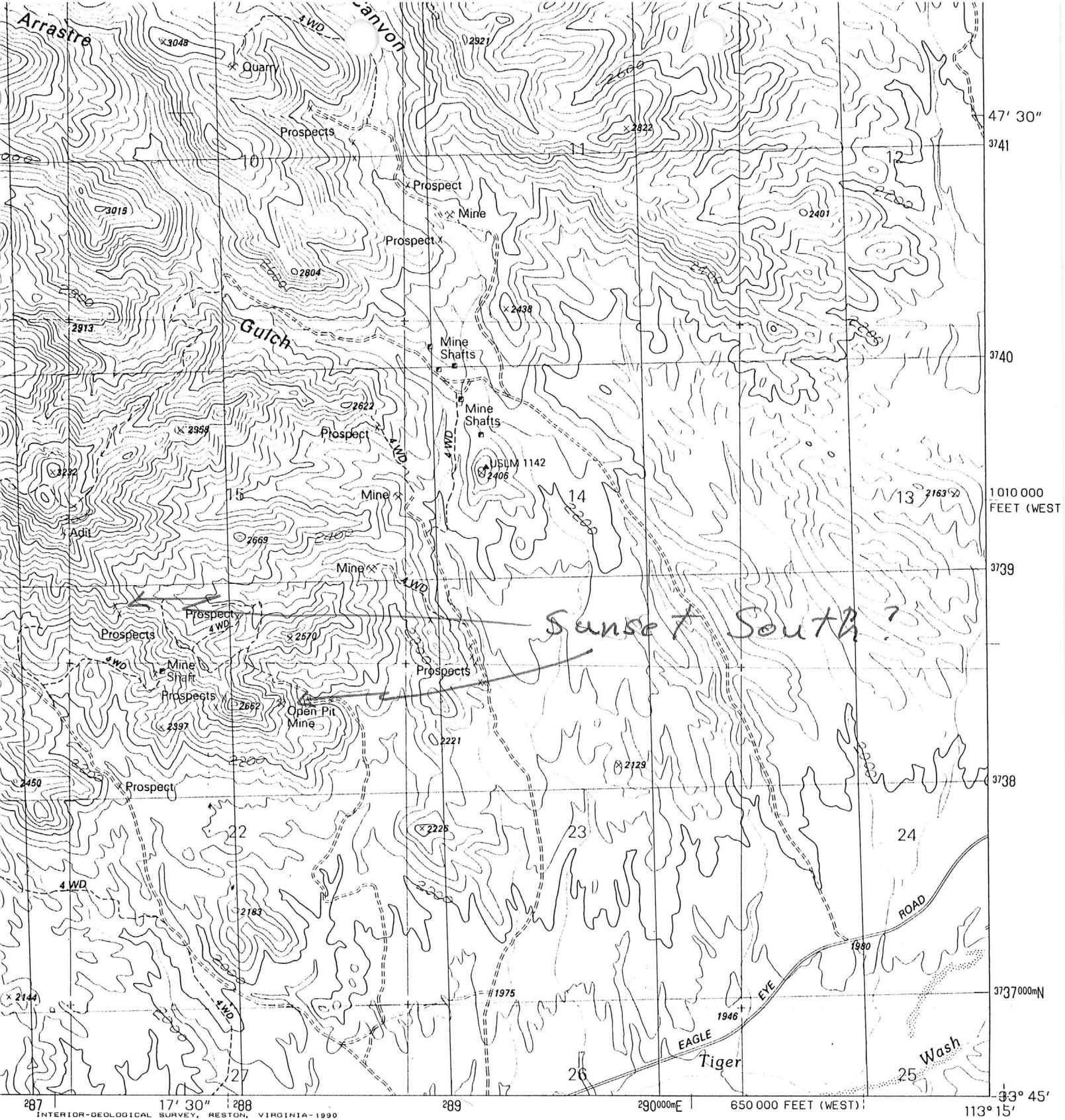

Frank stated that he had contracted the mining of the marble to Ike K@sisto at \$3.00 per ton up to 100 t.p.d. and \$2.00 per ton for over 100 t.p.d. The haul was contracted for \$3.00 per ton for 32 miles. The material (white) will be sold to U.S. Marble Corp.'s mill near Wenden, for \$10.00 per ton, provided U.S. Marble continues to operate at their present rate. Evidently U.S. Marble is dubious about their white marble reserves and is preparing to supplement their own production.
