Your Memo of around December 29 concerning the purported operations of one Mr. Lewis W. Hoffman at the Yellow Kid (otherwise known as the Yaller Kid) didn't quite register at first because I knew that nothing was doing on the Yellow Kid. This morning Mr. Hoffman walked in and the name and face registered and the whole setup clicked. Mr. Hoffman has made several trips to examine the Yellow Kid + that is all. He is looking for a property for purchase. In particular he is looking for a Gold property (Smart lad). I believe he has financial backing. I egged him onto the Zulu Gold out of Payson. He can't make the trip now because he is fresh out of Petrol. See what you can do in his behalf. I believe he is a sincere seeker. I know it is hard to say anything to help these boys out who are lining up their Gold - but we have to line 'em up somehow. The Swiss Girl g roup of claims, consisting of I3 patented claims has been bough t from the County by Mr Arthur R. Brashear of Humboldt, Ariz. He has begun operations to develop and has started a new shaft a short distance from one of the ols shafts near the north end of the property. The work starts on a 5 foot vein of copper ore, copper in a quartz gangue fissure having granite walls.

There has been a good road made to most all parts of the property, and Brashear has moved in a portable compressor, drills and other tools.

Brashear is leasing parts of the ground that he is not going to work himself. Two parties have already sampled a 100 foot shaft and got assays of 7% copper and 70 oz silver over 5 feet and are now signing up for a lease from one to twenty years.

The Swiss Girl group of claims, consisting of I3 patented claims has been bought from the County by Mr Arthur R. Brashear of Humboldt, Ariz.
