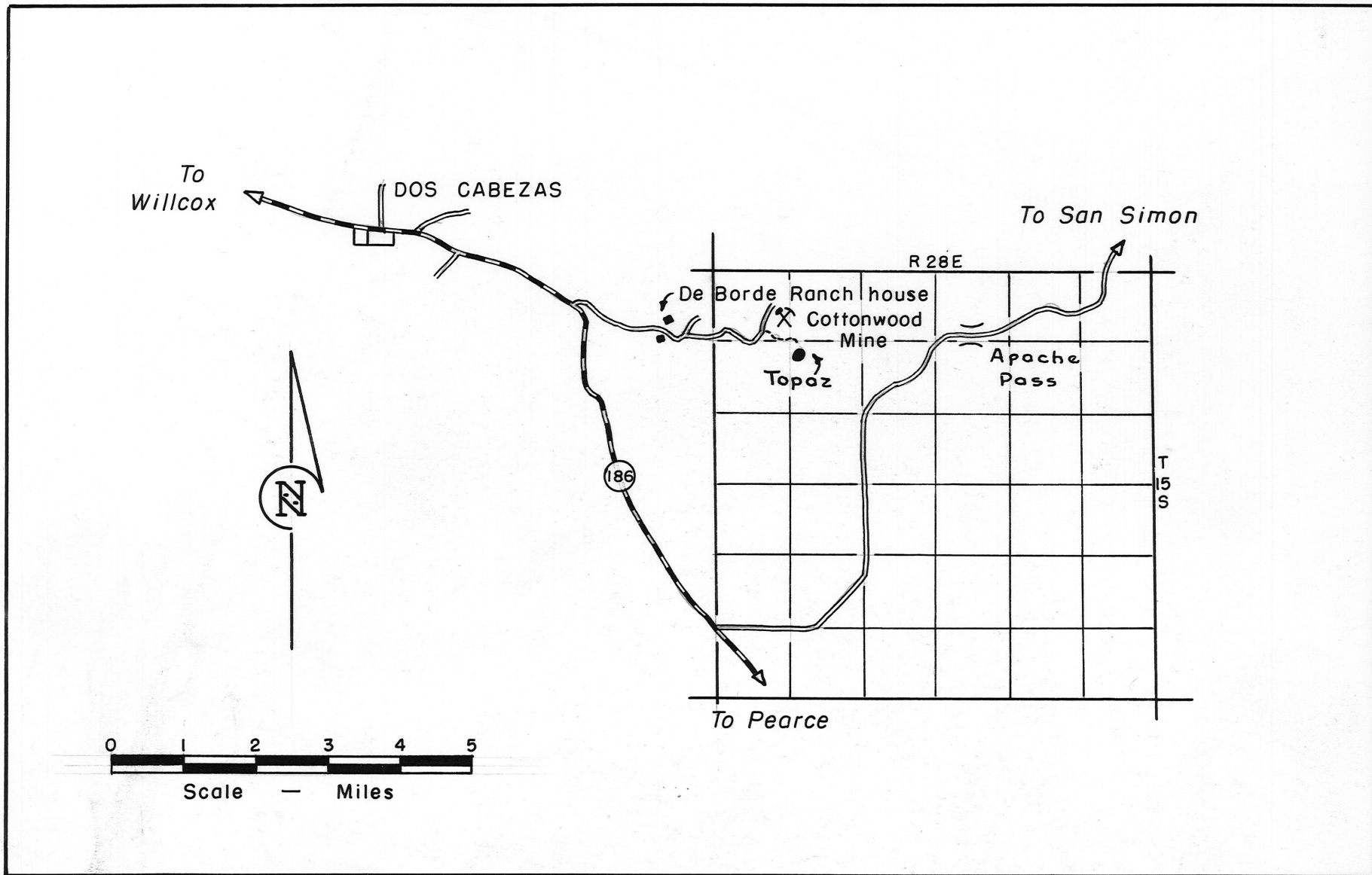


Fig. 1 Location map of Dos Cabezas Topaz deposit, Cochise County
