



NJN WR 5/2/87: Graham Sutton (card) reported that he has an application pending for the Toucan Quarry located on State Land, T9N R1W Sec 31, E of SW, W of SE. The material is rhyolite with lovely liesegang patterns and is marketed locally. The estimated minimum royalty on this material will be \$10 a ton with a 500 ton minimum.

NJN WR 10/2/87: Grahm Sutton (card) operating as Dig More Mining, 1425 E. University #9, Tempe, Arizona 85281, 968-1020, (home) 831-9380 visited. Mr. Sutton reported they have a 7,000 ton decorative stone reserve at the Toucan Quarry (file) Yavapai County. Of that, about 30% will probably be lost to undersize material. Their current plans are to mine approximately 500 tons per year for 3 years. At this mining rate they estimate their costs, including capitablizing their mining equipment, to be \$75 per ton.

KAP WR 10/2/87: Graham Sutton (card), Dig More Mining (card) was in and reported his decorative pattern or banded rhyolite business is doing well. A few stone yards in the Salt River Valley are selling the material and at least one has ordered their second 10 ton lot. He quarries the material by drilling and blasting using ANFO and medium velocity primers in an effort to limit shattering of the material. Blasted material is then hand selected and loaded for market. The current selling price to stone yards is \$130.00 per ton.

NJN WR 3/11/88: Graham Sutton (card) of Digmores Mining, reports that they mined and shipped over 100 tons of landscape boulders from their Toucan Quarry (file) Yavapai County. The quarry has been reclaimed and the State Land Department is returning their bond money.
