



Rich Lundin (c) visited and reported that the Trails End mine, owned by Ike Kusisto (c) is located in T14N R10W Sec 19 NW, Mohave County. Old workings include a 35' shaft and some prospect pits. Geology of the area consists of quartz sericite alteration and quartz vein mineralization in precambrian (?) granites. There appears to be a low angle thrust plate that outcrops about 100' paralleling the local wash. In places, the thrust is a 30' thick pyritic zone. The shaft is on a high angle shear zone, possibly related to the low angle structure. Samples taken by Mr. Lundin range between .06 and .3 oz/ton Au. Recent activities consist of Mr. Kusisto leasing the mine to three Massachusetts prospectors who have done some surface sampling.
