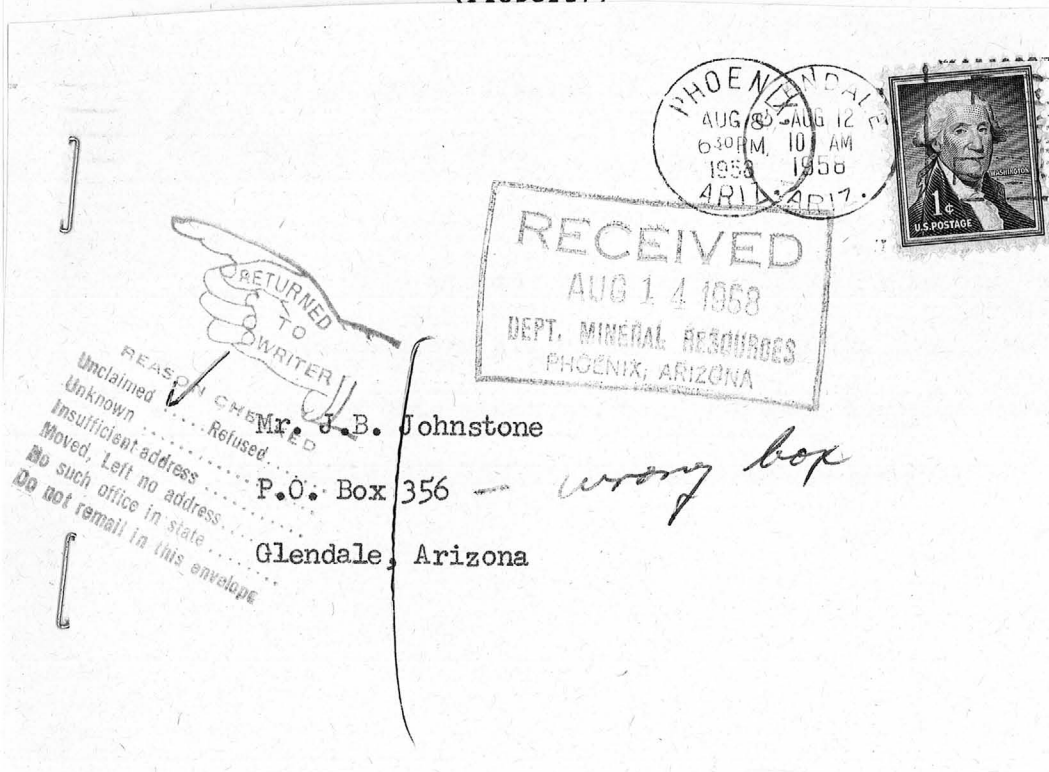

23. Geology & Mineralization Quartz veins (at least two) in granite. Largest about 18" wide. Strike N-65-E dip 85-W. The veins are traceable in places for about 700'. The mineralization is wolframite and pyrite. The mineralization is weak.

24. Ore: Positive & Probable, Ore Dumps, Tailings None

24-A Vein Width, Length, Value, etc. None

25. Mine, Mill Equipment & Flow Sheet None

26. Road Conditions, Route Go to Carl Pleasant Dam. Take Morgan Ranch road, 10 miles N. of dam. Take east fork - go 3 miles and take east fork again. Fort Tule is about 3 miles along this road. Best to get information as to road condition before going in. Very poor road after leaving the Morgan Ranch road.

27. Water Supply Poor. Just sufficient for domestic purposes. Milling operation could probably be handled near Lake Pleasant.

28. Brief History District has been prospected for gold and silver for sixty years. Small amounts of tungsten were mined and milled in 1938 or 1939. See J. S. Coupal or Niel Clark of Phoenix.

30. Remarks This property has not much to recommend it except as a possible small hi-grade producer.
