Reference is made to your memo of November 27th re- the Victory mine, belonging to J. V. Leonard, 408 N. 10th Street, Phoenix, in which you state he called and discussed with you the needs of an engineer, etc.

You stated that he is without transportation and was leaving for his mine on December 1st and would expect me to meet him there on Monday, December 14th. That Leonard refused to meet me at Salome, or Aguila, and would expect me to meet him on said date at his mine, etc.

Yesterday morning, Monday, Dec. 14th, I left here in company with Mr. Edwin W. Mills, who kindly offered to go with me. I had found out that Moser's well is located on the Salome-Buckeye road 27 miles southeast of here. Well, we left here at 7 A. M. and drove down to Moser's well. Luckily, we found both Moser and his wife there.

Now what I am going to tell you, Sam, is absolutely confidential, so when Leonard calls again, please keep Moser's name out of it. Also ask Billy Graham to do the same.

Moser stated that Leonard's Victory mine is located soutwest of Moser's Well about 25 miles, from which point it is reached by a most deplorable road or rather trail. He stated that some time back a man strated out to the mine with Leonard and broke an exlemear the mine and had to walk back. He became exhausted on road, but finally reached Moser's well. Later that day Leonard walked in to Moser's Well. Moser also stated that sometime ago, he hauled Leonard out to his so-called mine in his Model A Ford. That he had a hard timereaching property - had to cross some rocky steep gulches where he had to drag his tires, and that he could not return that way, due to two steep grades, and came back another and worse way where he almost wrecked his car. In short, Moser advised us not to try to make the trip in my car, as he said it would probably wreck it or drag my retreads off, which are not so hot, as one of them is already showing signs of disintegration.

Another thing, Moser said there were so many cross roads and trails over which the cattlemen are going in all directions he doubted we could find our way out there. But he drew us a sketch map and Mills and I dreve across a big valley over sand dunes, deep chuck holes and around mezquite brush until we got to the foot hills, where the road dwindled to a trail and got worse and worse. Moser had already told us that the worst part of the road lay ahead this side of the mine, etc. So, I said to Mills: "We had better return" - and he agreed with me. So we returned to Moser's well, and he said we had done the right thing that he would not attempt this trip again himself, etc. So, when Leonard comes in, just tell him I made an effort to reach his place, but the trail was so bad I turned back. Why, the old moss-back, did not even have his trail signed! So I am off of trying to makethis trip again.



Sam and Charlie passed through here today enroute to Salt Lake City, as you know. Sam showed me your wire urging that I examine "Leonard's Victory Mine, at Johns Wells," and to advise you of date by mail.

We have made enquiries and cannot figure out just what mine you refer to, unless you mean the old Wrigley mine, which has been re-named the VICTORY mine, under lease to the VICTORY MINES & MILL-ING COMPANY, controlled by Frank Nelson, of Kingman. This property is located on the east side of the Cerbat Mountains. We have contacted Nelson on this date. He has made application, through Hilton, who is in charge of the grazing service here, for an access road project to the Victory mine. Also, I have arranged to visit this mine next Tuesday, November 17th, in company with Nelson, who is arranging to apply for an RFC loan.

Please advise me at once by letter or wire, giving more exact information as to the mine you want me to examine, as I cannot locate either the property or the owner thereof, unless it is the one controlled by Nelson.

On November 16th, I received the following wire from Billy Graham:

"VICTORY MINE OWNED BY J V LEONARD OF PHOENIX. MINE LOCATED AT OLD JONES WELL NOW CALLED LEONARD WELL, 45 MILES NORTHWEST OF BUCKEYE. COUPAL AND HASTINGS BOTH SHOULD KNOW ABOUT PROPERTY AS LEONARD CONTACTED THEM. IMPORTANT YOU ADVISE ME WHEN LEONARD CAN MEET YOU AT PROPERTY". BILLY GRAHAM.

Kindly advise Billy that I did not answer his letter as I wanted to take this matter up with you on November 18th, on your return from Salt Lake City. As we did not see each other on your return, you can tell him I will be in and around Salome from November 14th to November 18th. Hence, if satisfactory to yourselves, and to Mr. Leonard, I can meet him at Aguila on Monday, November 14th, at 8 A. M. on that date. We can then go from there to the mine. Hunting old wells and dim roads in that country is out. Let him meet me at Aguila, as stated, if that date is okay all around. I could hardly meet him in that neck of the woods sooner, MMEXEMS unless I should be directed to make a special trip down there the last week in this month; but on second thought, that is out too, as I am scheduled here in such a manner that I could not go until the date above mentioned.

I have your memorandum of November 20 regarding the Victory mine. Mr. John V. Leonard, 408 North 10th Street, Phoenix, called and I discussed with him in detail the property and his need for an engineer.

Leonard is without transportation and he is leaving on December 1st to go to the mine. I told him that I knew the difficulties of trying to find a mine out in the desert unless specific directions were available and I also note your comments on this point. There is a ranch at Moser Well, which is located on the road about 4 miles north west of Burnt Well. The rancher who lives at Moser Well (who I believe is a Mr. Moser) hauls equipment, supplies and so forth to Leonard at his mine and is well acquainted with the property and also the road conditions. I believe you can readily locate the Moser Well as being 4 miles on the road north west of Burnt Well, which is a well known location.

Leonard will expect you at the property on Monday, December 14th. I tried to get Leonard to agree to meet you at Aguila or Salome, but was unable to do so as he is not only hard headed and a little sore at the lack of attention but also hard of hearing so that it is impossible to talk with him.

The mine workings are accessible and I know that Leonard wants to get a loan and has pestered Washington and also the RFC office here in Phoenix. He should have a rough sketch of the property and the workings and I believe several samples should be cut to show just what he has in the line of ore. With that done he will have enough information to decide on a loan. I would suggest that you try and make him pay for the assays on the necessary samples you take, but if he baulks on this then we will have to pay for the assaying; however, as he has a pension and our funds are limited it seems to me as though he should pay for the assays.

Dear Mr. Leonard:

After talking with you the other day I am of the opinion that your application should be for an R.F.C. development lean known as the Class "B" lean rather than the preliminary development or Class "C" lean for which you are making application. Any mine in which the workings are open and accessible qualifies under the "B" lean.

When you make application for the loan you should include a sketch of the claims and the relations of the workings to them, as well as a sketch of the underground development. These need not be surveyed maps but merely sketches as close to scale as you can make them, You should also include a list of assays, giving location and width of ore sampled, as well as a list of any shipments you have made. Outline the nature of the work which you intend to perform and give an approximate cost of such work. These are things which you yourself must do as they are the only means that the R.F.C. engineers have of determining the value of your property.

We will try to have Mr. Elgin B. Holt call it the mine the next time he is in the vicinity, however, you should not delay your application pending this visit.
