

1. Name of Claim

Wanda #3

2. Location

The survey made in 1962 places this claim in the SER NET Section 26, T 12N, R 2 W, G&SRB. Located on aerial photo overlay EGE-11-34.

3. Owner and Address

Paul Bryant 847 Lincoln Prescott, Arizona

4. Date owner accuired claim and how acquired

The claim was located on August 25, 1951 by Mr. Bryant and Mr. Kirkpatrick and was recorded in the Yavapai County Courthouse in Book 159, page 82 on August 27, 1951. The late Mr. Kirkpatrick's heirs are living in the State of Washington according to Mr. Bryant.

5. Improvements

- (a) Cabin 12'x21' made of lumber and tin. No value.
- (b) Barn 12'x21' made of lumber and tin. No value.
- (c) Shed 12'x12' made of lumber and tin. No value.
- (d) Shed 9'x12' made of lumber and tin. No value.
- (e) Dug well. Dry.

6. Mining Improvements

(a) Discovery pit 20'x25'x15' deep. No recent work

(b) Caved tunnel. This tunnel is completely caved in and is located just below the discovery pit.

(c) Trench 10'x300'x3'. This excavation starts from the discovery pit and goes down the hill.
(d) Trench 15'x50'x5'.
(e) Shaft 5'x7'x7' caved. The area surrounding this shaft has been cut and leveled.

Shaft 3'x5'x25'. This shaft has water at the bottom of it.

7. How claim is being used

Mr. Bryant claims to be holding it for mining purposes.

8. Financial status and occupation of claiment

Paul Bryant is employed by the Miller Valley Builders Supply at 609 Division Street, Prescott, Arizona.

9. Other Pertinent date on claimant

Mr. Bryant is 50 years old and in good health.

10. General

Mr. Bryant stated that he was a miner for 19\frac{1}{2} years and that his only interest in the Wanda #3 is for mining purposes. Mr. Bryant plans to acquire ownership of the entire claim when it is determined which of the Kirkpatrick heirs is heir to half of the claim.

The cabin on this claim is of a very substandard nature and is being used by vagrants, hunters and others for purposes other than mining. The claim is not being mined. The photographs of the improvements will bear out the fact that the cabin and sheds are located in a hazardous chaparral fuel type. Use of this claim threatens to hinder National Forest protection. It is a definite fire hazard.


WANDA #3 SE¹/₄ NE¹/₂ Sec. 26, T. 12N., R. 2W. G&SRB M







