Subject: Information from office interview with Bob Cobllo

Bob Cobllo, 2506 E. Highland, Mesa, Arizona 85203 was in for information on fluxes for smelting lead-silver ores for his own use. I convinced him that trying to smelt his own ores would, even if he was successful, be very costly and it is likely he wouldn't be successful. He was provided numerous metallurgy texts to study which detailed the complexity of smelting. He reported to be able to produce high silver content silver-lead ores from his War Eagle Mine (a new file to be made), Yavapai County, near Goodwin on Turkey Creek, (Yavapai MILS # 1101A). He wants to start by producing a test lot of ore and it was such a lot he thought he could smelt himself. He claimed silver assay values as high as 500 tr oz/ton. He has run numerous assays on the property and although the literature, (USGS Bull. 782, p.150) reports the property to be a lead, zinc and silver deposit, the zinc content did not exceed a few tenths of one percent. He has contacted the Cominco smelter at Trail, British Columbia and received a smelter schedule. Mike Jacobs of Jacobs of Jacobs Assay Office in Tucson recommended he contact Allied ??? in Tucson who would buy a high grade silver concentrate. Based on information on the BLM microfiche the War Eagle is an unpatented claim straddling the section line between Secs. 17 and 20, T.12N., R.1W.; AMC 87654 and owned or located by J.R. Manifee, P.O. Box 917, Bagdad, Arizona 86321.

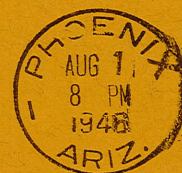
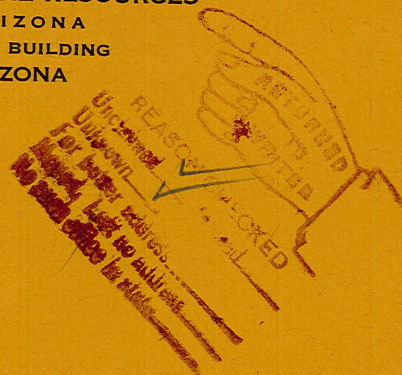
