

Preliminary Report on Mining Claims

1. Name of Claim

4. Date owner acquired claim and how acquired

The Century Mining Company purchased one-half interest in the claim from J. B. Williams, George W. Childs Jr., Bill T. Turner, and C. E. Bettinger on July 28, 1959. This transaction is recorded in Book 161 of Official Records, on page 216 at the Yavapai County Recorder's office.

This group purchased their one-half interest from John Hicks, Bill Huffman and Darlesee Huffman on July 15, 1959. This is recorded in Book 159 of Official Records on page 148. The Century Mining Company purchased their other one-half interest from John Hicks, Bill Huffman and Darlesee Huffman. This is recorded in Book 161 of Official Records on page 218.

Bill and Darlesee Huffman purchased their interest in the claim from Waldo E. Stephens on February 15, 1954. This transaction is recorded in Book 28 of Official Records on page 277.

Stephens located the claim on September 22, 1953 and it was recorded in Book 24 of Official Records, page 541 on December 21, 1953. A search at the Yavapai County Recorder's Office failed to uncover how or when John Hicks became part owner of this claim.

5. Improvements

- (a) House 9' X 12' constructed of lumber and tin. Also has a framework structure next to it. This house has no value.
- (b) Outdoor fireplace of stone. No value.

6. Mining Improvements

- (a) Shaft, 4' X 5' X ? deep. This shaft is badly caved and shows no evidence of any mining in ten years.
- (b) Trench, 10' X 20' X 8' deep into hillside. Also has not been worked on in ten years as evidenced by the layer of pine needles at the bottom.
- (c) Pit, 10' X 10' X 5' deep and has a heavy layer of pine needles at its base.
- (d) 50' X 60' X 15' deep trench into hillside. This is a bulldozed trench and is approximately five years old.
- (e) There is also other bulldozer work evident on the claim and it is from three to five years old.

7. How claim is being used

This claim is not being used for mining purposes. The building on the claim is very rundown and is not a principal place of residence for the claimant.

8. Financial status and occupation of the owner

This information, as well as other pertinent data on the claimant, is unknown as no contact has been made with the owner.

9. General

This claim is located near the edge of the pine and chaparral types. There is a fair stand of pines near the claim with a heavy brush understory. The substandard building present on the claim is periodically occupied by hunters and presents a fire hazard to a highly flammable area.




