

Mr. & Mrs. White have found a remote breccia vein containing 5 - 10% visible galena. They plan to take some samples then contact a DMR engineer for a field visit. Assays on their 3 select samples were: 4.1 oz/ton Ag; 3.7 oz/ton Ag; 0.14 oz/ton Au; and 0.9% Cu and 3.4% Cu. (WR KAP 10-21-77) a.t.

KP/WR 11/30/79 - Rexford White reported he has been mining at the White Mine, producing gold, silver, lead and some zinc from pockets between granite (probably in a quartz vein). He said he built the chemical smelter by himself. He is crushing ore by hand, screening it and treating it chemically.



Dear Mr. White:

In answer to your letter dated December 29, 1978 just received, I believe your best course of action is to visit the Department of Mineral Resources at the Arizona State Fairgrounds in Phoenix (phone 255-3791), and talk to one of their engineers. No one can offer any reasonable treatment for an ore without examining a representative sample. We need much more information than you gave in your letter. If you wish, you could send a sample to this laboratory and, at no cost to you, we could then talk to you on the phone or write you with perhaps some better advice regarding a logical treatment.




