GW WR 12/11/75: Went to the White Spar barite-lead-silver property in Sec. 35, T12N R3W, about 4 miles NE of Wilhoit. Here the outcrop at the collar of an inclined shaft is a vein of quartz and barite 5 feet thick, but due to the thick chaparral we were unable to trace it more than 20 or 30 feet. The shaft was inaccessible because of no ladders and only one stull.
