Metals Corporation of America E. Alfred Haralson, President, 105 Highway East, Safford 85546 - (428-1852)

Have been staking around Copper Creek Arizona and probably east of Jackson Mountain.

As near as I can find out, the U.S. Lime & Mining has been taken over by The Yates Petroleum Co. of Artesia. As to whether they will operate as U.S. Lime & Mining or Yates Petroleum Co. has not been decided. They still hold A. H. Haralson Jr.'s diatomaceous earth property southeast of Safford. See map of diatomaceous earth and chabazite properties north of Bowie in Graham County. GWI 2-9-68

Metals Corporation of America appears to have taken the place of the U.S. Lime & Mining with offices in the same building. They are interested in the diatomaceous earth southeast of Safford. GWI QR 4-1968

Metals Corporation of America has apparently taken over the U.S. Lime & Mining Co., with offices in the same building. Mike Riebold is Chairman of the Board, E. Alfred Haralson, President. At present they are working on diatomaceous earth southeast of Safford. They were talking of putting in complete assay facilities. GWI QR 6-1968

Three companies, Union Carbide, Grace Chemical Corp., and Western Industrial Minerals have been doing their assessment work on their chabazite deposits in T11S, R28, 29E, all just north of the County line. Western Minerals is supposed to have obtained their claims from Norton Abrasives for \$5 the indication being that this is a subsidiary of Norton Abrasives. In T8S, R28E, Mr. Al Haralson has option 6 sections of diatomaceous earth claims to Metals Corp. of America. CWI QR 12-1968

George Bott said that Mike Reibold is back in the Aravaipa district with money to pay off past debts and assume ownership or control of the mining properties he previously held and also to acquire new ones. He is reported to have acquired certain of the Faulkner properties near Safford for \$100 cash. GWI WR 8/28/73

Field interview with Al Haralson, Safford, who says that he completed the assessment work on his diatomaceous earth claim near the 111 Ranch, S34 T8S R28E, southeast of Safford. He also says that PD & Amax have staked around his claims. GWI WR 10/22/73



- b) That certain Promissory Note bearing date of January 14, 1966, made by the Mortgagor to the order of the Mortgagoe in the principal sum of \$119,254.50 with interest at the rate of 7% per annum and being due and payable on demand;
- e) All extensions or renewals of said notes or any part thereof;
- d) Any and all indebtedness now or hereafter owed by Mortgagor to Mortgagee, whether direct or indirect, primary or secondary, fixed or contingent and irrespective of how the same may be evidenced or secured or may arise;
