

Summary of information received:

Mr. Goode explained that this white marble deposit in the south central part of Sec 31, T10S R13E is held by him under lease from the State Land Department. The leases are part of a multisection holding often referred to as the San Francisco Marble Quarries.

He explained that the marble is good quality white material suitable for livestock feed supplement, swimming pool sand and decorative rock.
