Location: Sec. 17-18, T13N, R5E, Four miles south of Camp Verde

Owner: Gale and Robert Wingfield, P.O. Box 21, Camp Verde, Arizona

Property: 10 Contiguous claims. (placer)

Description: The deposit is a member bed in the Verde Lake Series, and is 50 feet thick and several thousand feet are exposed along the strike. A few drill holes indicate a grade of 95% plus percent of  $\text{CaSO}_4$ .

The owners will lease, or sell, the property, and wanted possible buyers. They were referred to Union and <sup>Arizona</sup> American Gypsum Co<sup>s</sup>, of Phoenix, <sup>Arizona</sup> Union, in particular wants gypsum sources within 100 miles of Ashfork. Since <sup>Arizona</sup> Union has been furnishing gypsum to the Rillito Cement Plant from Feldman, and since Rillito plans to erect a plant at Ashfork it is probably Union that will be most interested. The reported plant at Ashfork hopes for a contract to produce 3,500,000 barrels of cement, during the construction of Glenn Canyon Dam. Since iron from Seligman and Limestone, in the Verde District, are also available, a source of raw materials is evident.
