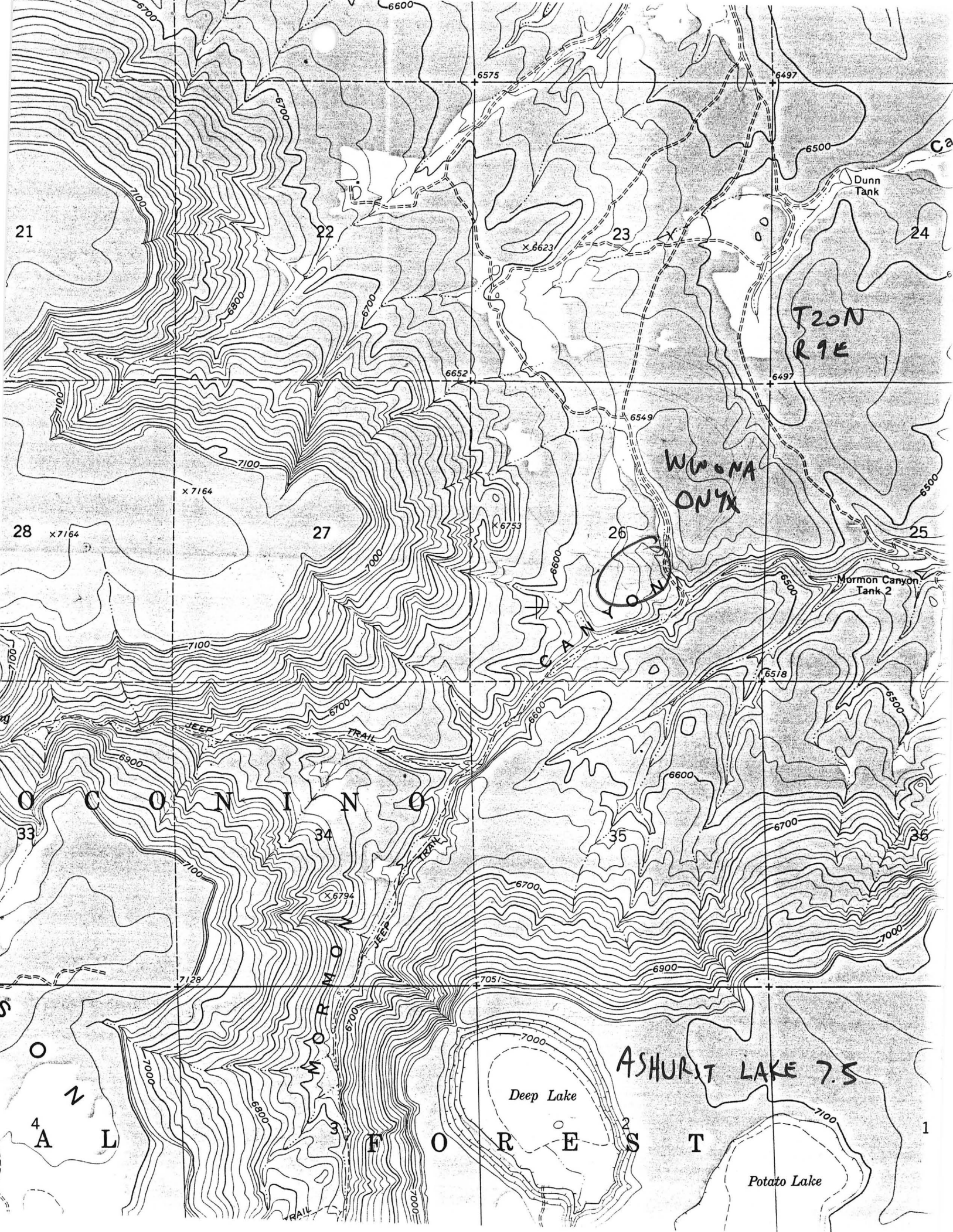

NJN WR 6/24/88: Willie Rozza (card) who I have been assisting with onyx and travertine deposits in the State, reported he has found two onyx occurrences south of Winona located about 5 miles apart, that have been previously prospected. The largest and best currently has a 30' X 6' exposure and contains the fine, dark brown material resembling that on display in the Museum. He reported the location of this occurrence, to be called Winona Onyx and noted that it is on the west side of the road but cannot be seen unless you walk over to the outcrops.
