The old Wolf Property, now held by Pan M. Mining Company is located near the town of Stanley. Sect. 2, T<sup>1</sup>S, R19E.

Grad Stapp is manager.

The company plans to drill a contact - metamorphic zone next to a sill, which has brecciated the Tornado Limestone. Strong Epidote-garnet zones adjoin the sill. Bornite and chalcopyrite and oxide minerals of copper present.

Two cars of sorted dump material is reported to have run 3+% copper.
