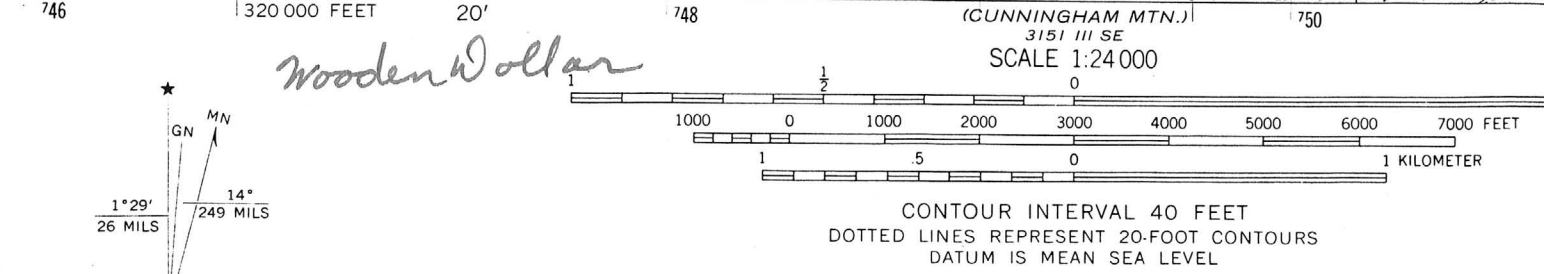
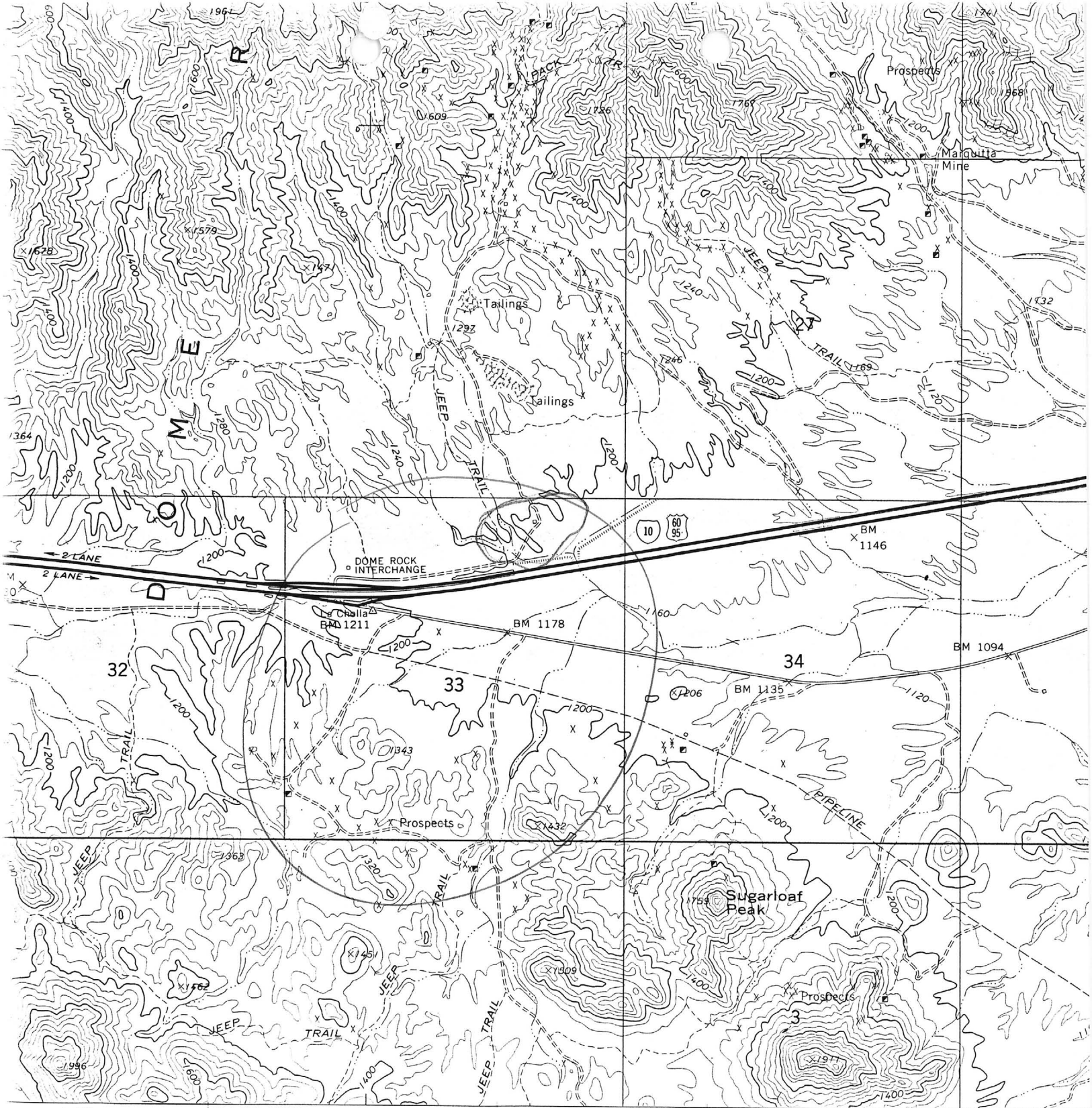

Mr. White reported that he is planning a 20 ton per day pilot operation to test "nonconventional recovery" methods on placer concentrates produced by conventional concentration methods. He was very noncommittal about the details, but promised more information. He said he has been using a metallurgical consultant who has developed and is evaluating the process. He said preliminary testing has indicated that over 85 % of the precious metal values are in the non-free gold portion of the concentrates.
