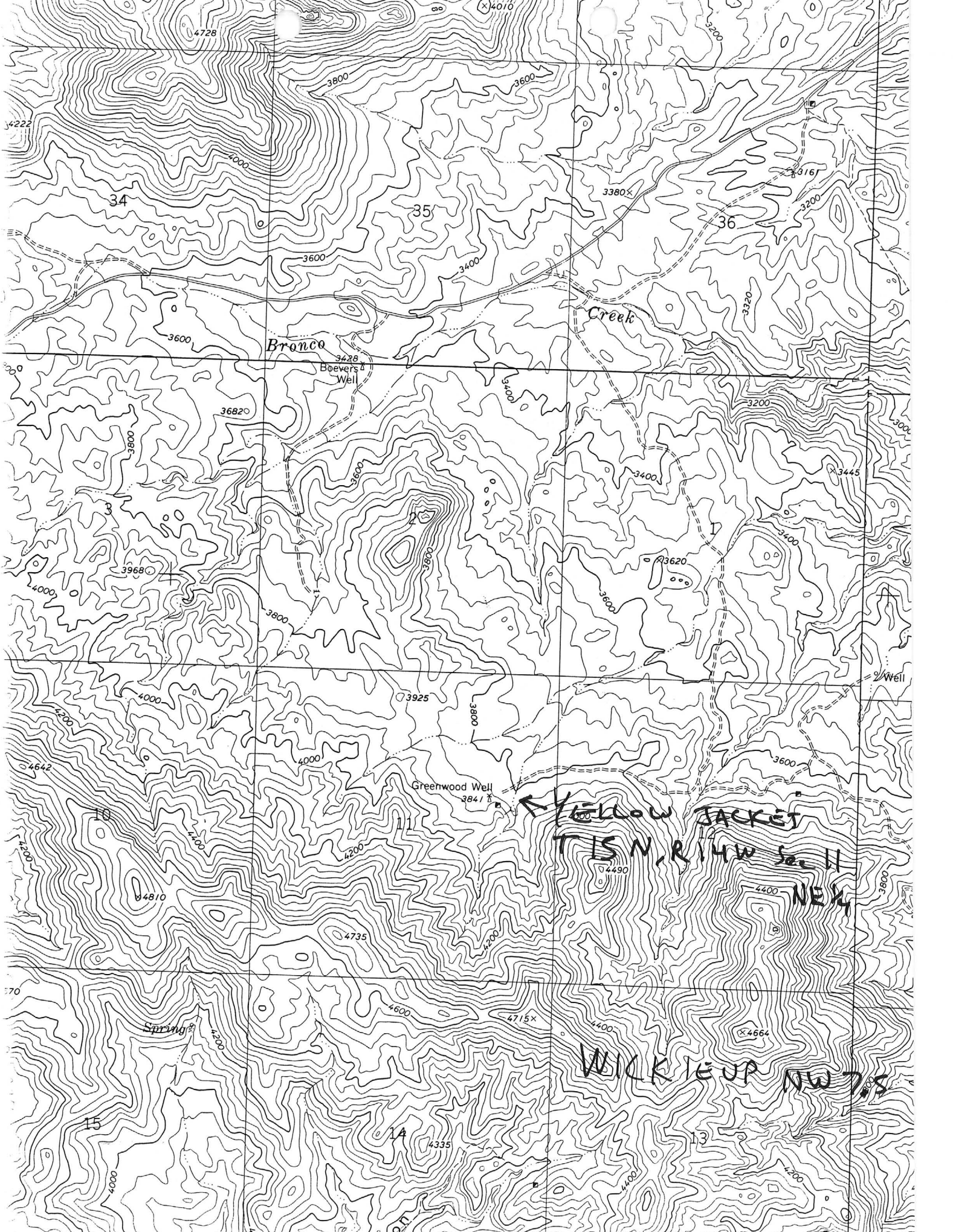

Zep called for information on custom mills he could process ore at from the Yellow Jacket mine. Suggested Stutenroth for gravity, Malartic Hygrade for cyanide and Magma at Superior for flotation. Cautioned him about pay metals, fees and deductions. He did not explain his financial position in the property.

Not related: Nyal changed the location and MILS # of the property from 457A to 458A based on information from Harvey Smith

Accompanied Mr. Denton to the Yellow Jacket mine, about 7 miles west of Wikieup where Mr. Wist Cunningham, California, was dozing the dump out into the wash. A dozer cut had been made about 150 feet long on the footwall of the vein and to a depth of 30 feet in the vicinity of the old 400 foot vertical shaft. Some ore could be found in the muck where the 3 foot wide mineralized shear zone in granite had been dozed out. According to Mr. Cunningham, about 20 tons per day are shipped to the Tonto Basin mill where it will be concentrated when a stockpile of 350 tons has accumulated. The ore is said to run 12-14% Zn, .39% Cd, 11-12 oz. Ag and 0.17 oz. Au per ton. Mr. Cunningham said he had to dispose of the cons for which a tentative agreement had been made with AS&R but a longer range contract was being negotiated on the Coast with a Japanese firm. Mr. Rundle, Cyprus Corp., called for information on the Yellow Jacket mine 6 miles west of Wikieup saying the Bruce mine had been contacted regarding milling the high Zn ore. GW WR 12/19/74

Went to Wikieup where Dusty Denton said he had finished his annual claim work. He mentioned the Western Mining & Development Co., Marshall Samuels, president, had contacted him to mill some scheelite for them. He said the mine was at a turnoff near milepost 152. GW WR 8/27/75

Dusty Denton, Wikieup, phoned for information on patenting his mill site on the Big Sandy below Wikieup. I then called Bob McColley, BLM, and he said that as long as the mill site land was used for that purpose only, it could be patented. GW WR 1/9/76

YELLOW JACKET MINE

MOHAVE

Went on to the Yellow Jacket Mine of Gold Silver Resources Inc. and found the gate locked. GW WR 6/7/72

Went to the Yellow Jacket mine but the gate was locked. Tried to find Dusty Denton in Wikieup. His wife said he was working on a ranch and that the Yellow Jacket mine would be closed for several months. GW WR 7/20/72

Saw Dusty Denton at Wikieup who said they were going to start the Yellow Jacket mine again after long-holding 28 feet of sulfides. They have also cleaned out 50 feet of the old shaft where the vein is 4-6 feet wide and runs $\pm 13\%$ in oxide Cu, but due to the low silica they haven't been able to find a market. GW WR 9/6/72

It is reported work will resume at the Yellow Jacket mine after the first of the year. GW WR 12/6/72

Stopped at Wikieup and saw Dusty Denton who said he and Dennis Poyner, Kingman, are about to get enough finances to resume development at the Yellow Jacket. GW WR 1/4/73

Visited with Mr. Denton in Wikieup who said he and Mr. Poyner, Kingman, would renew work at the Yellow Jacket, 7 miles west of Wikieup, in about three weeks. They have 30 tons ready to ship but Inspiration wants a minimum shipment of 45-50 tons. GW WR 2/7/73

Stopped in Wikieup and visited with Dusty Denton who said he and Denis Poyner, Kingman, would be starting the Yellow Jacket mine soon and were trying to make a deal for the mill of Cactus Mining Company in Wikieup. GW WR 3/6/73

Stopped in Wikieup but Mr. Denton wasn't in. Next day stopped again but Mr. Denton wasn't in still. GW WR 6/6,7/73

The Yellow Jacket Au-Cu mine west of Wikieup closed after about a 3 month underground development program. GW Annual Report 6/29/73

Went to Wikieup and visited with "Dusty" Denton who said Denys Poyner was trying to raise finances to reopen the Yellow Jacket mine about 6 miles west of Wikieup. GW WR 10/3/73

Went to Wickieup but Dusty Denton was not in camp. Next day returned and Mrs. Denton said he and Dick Raney were building a road to the Golden Girl mine about 5 miles airline SW of Wickieup. GW WR 4-4-74

Went to Wikieup but both Dick Raney and Dusty Denton was gone. GW WR 5-1-74
