ON THE MOTHER LOSE

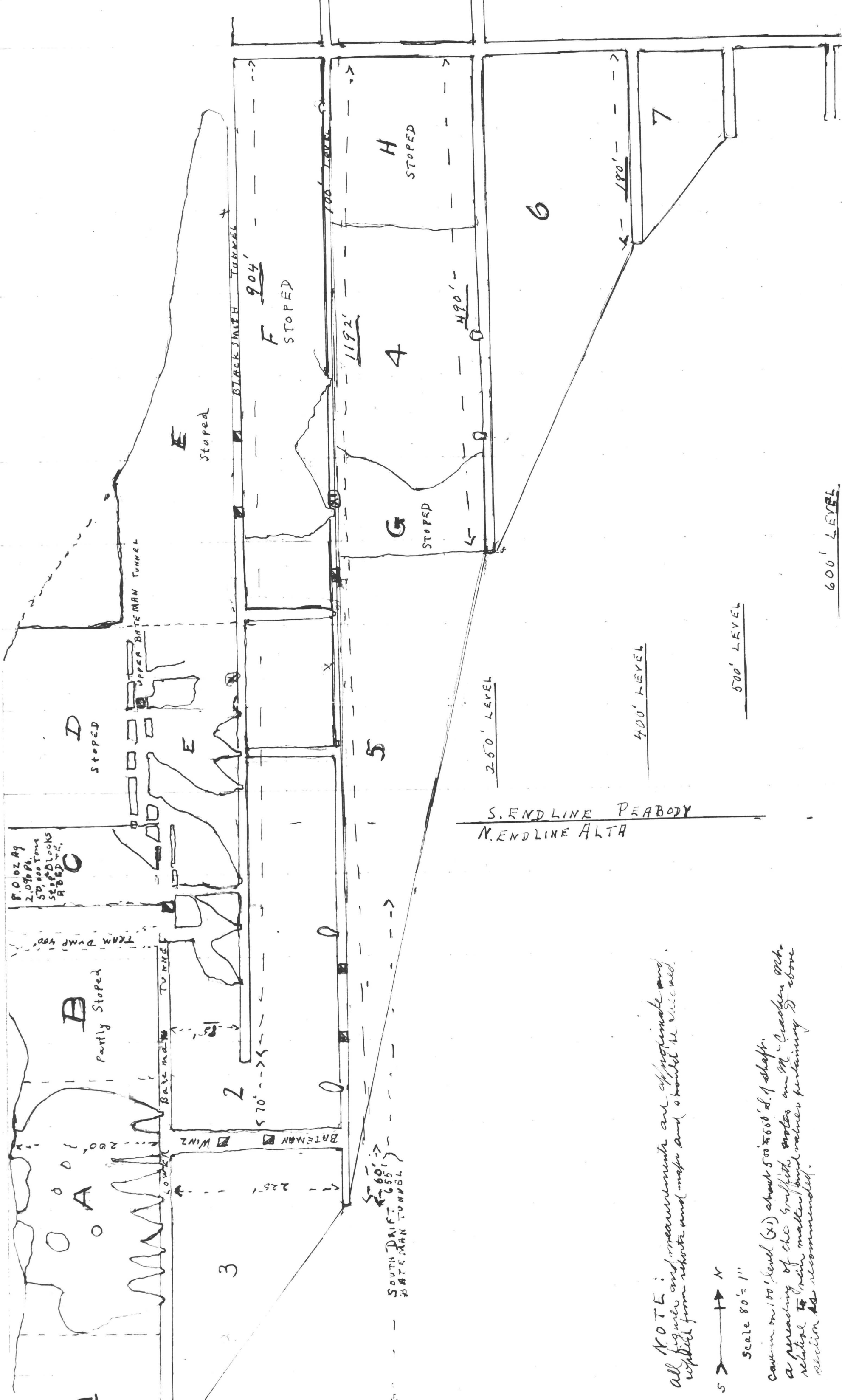
