and averages \$12.00 in gold.

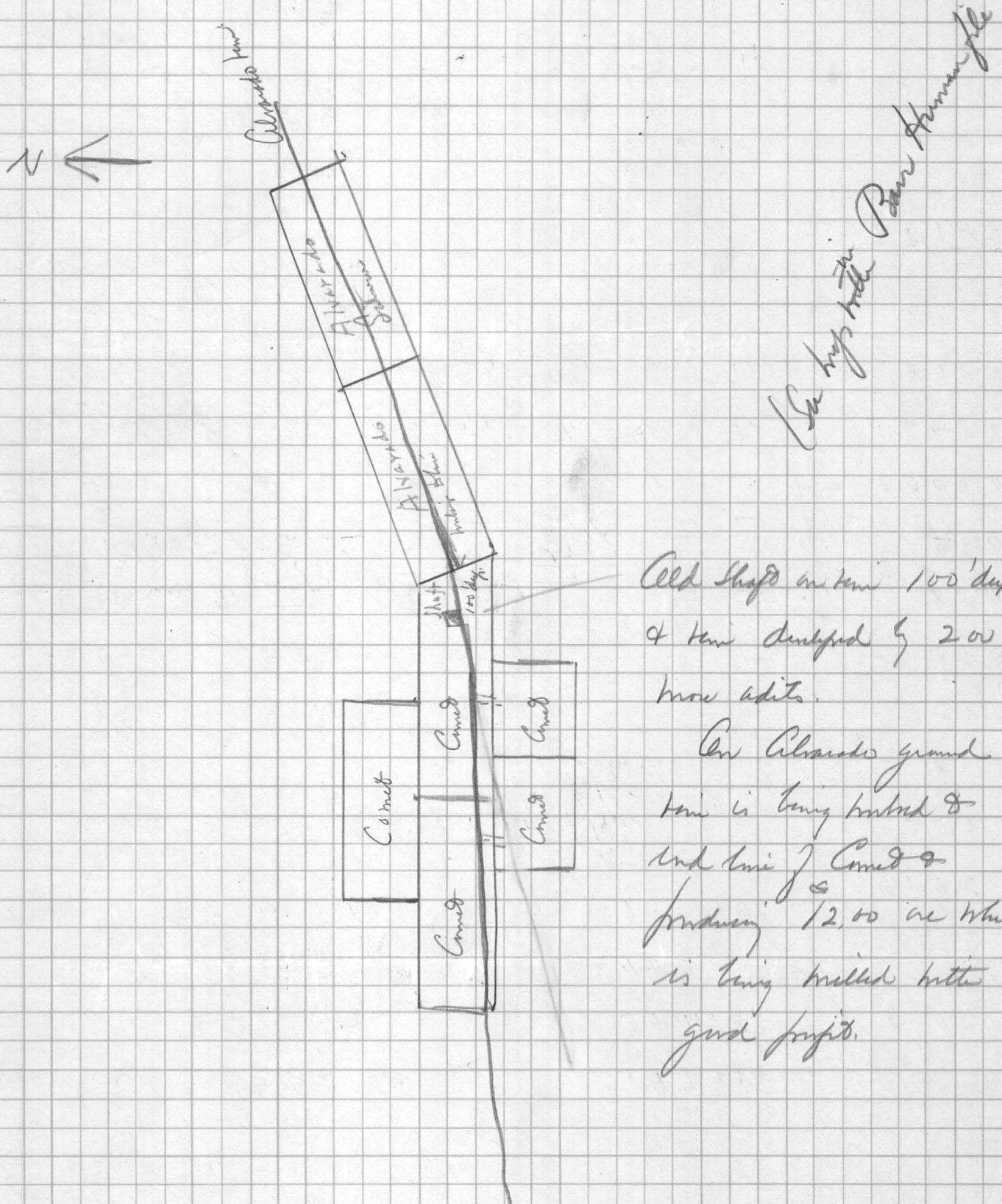
Davis who owns the Alvarado has been trying
