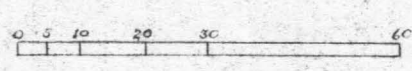

 November 16, 1912 Scale 1" = 30'

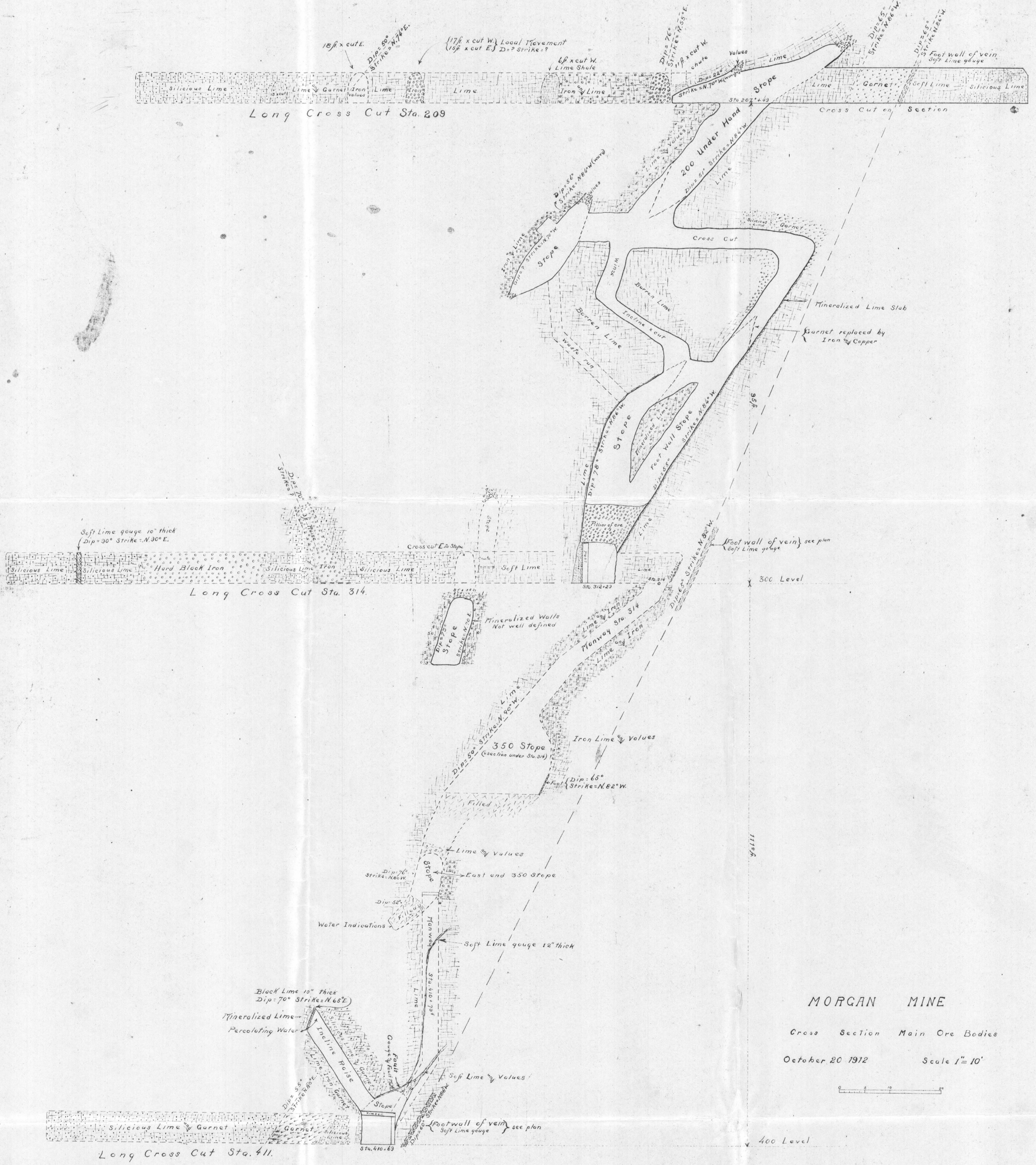

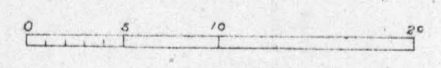

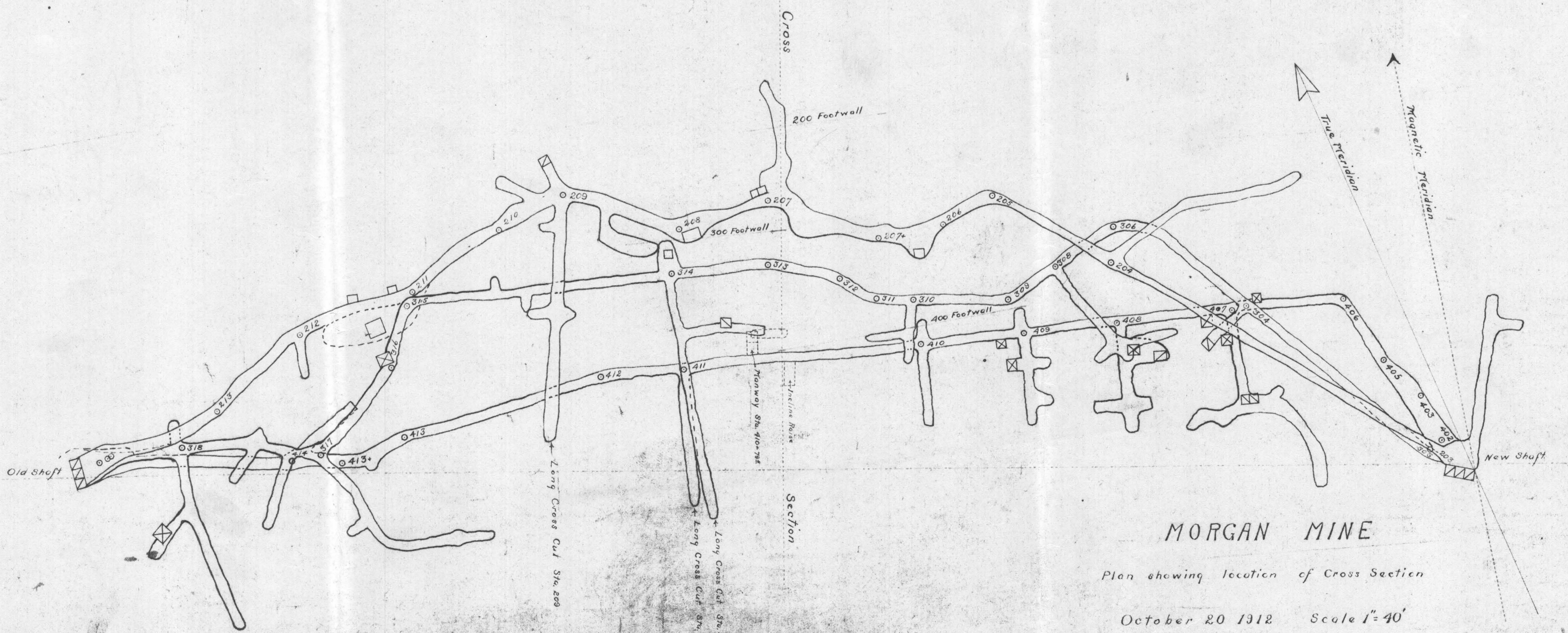

October 20 1912 Scale 1" = 10'



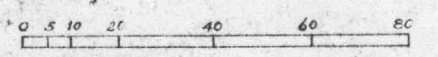

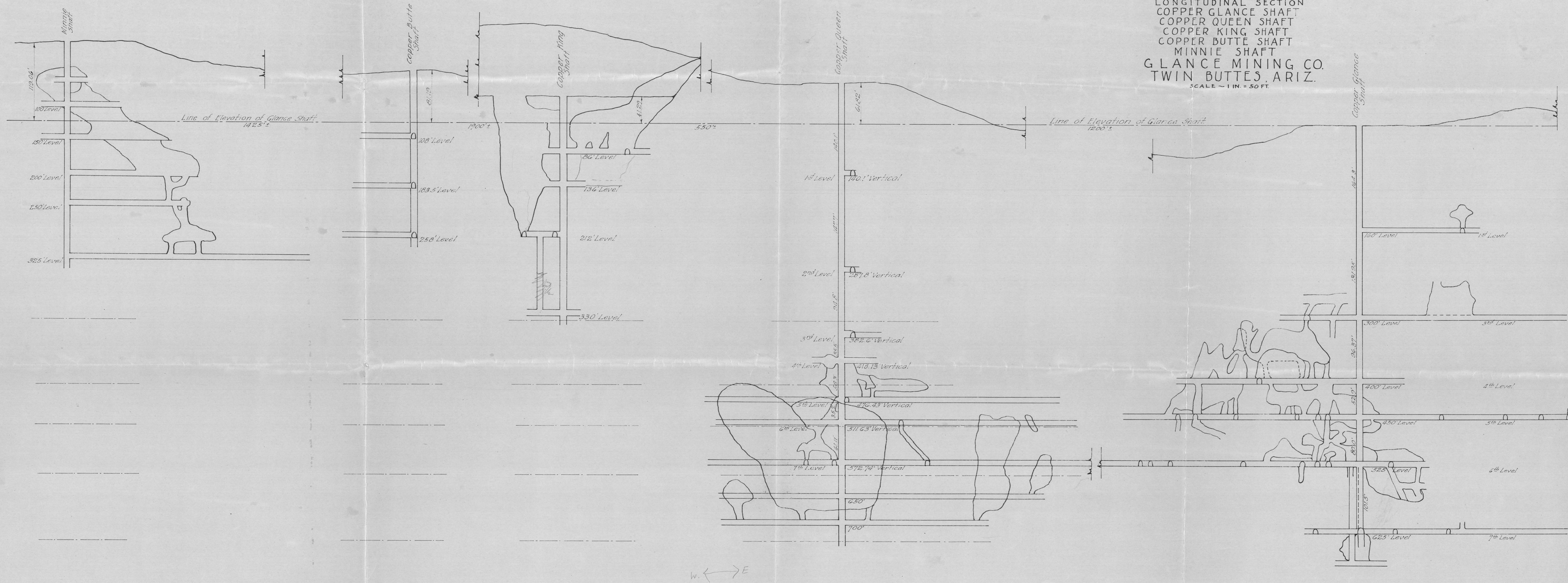
Plan showing location of Cross Section

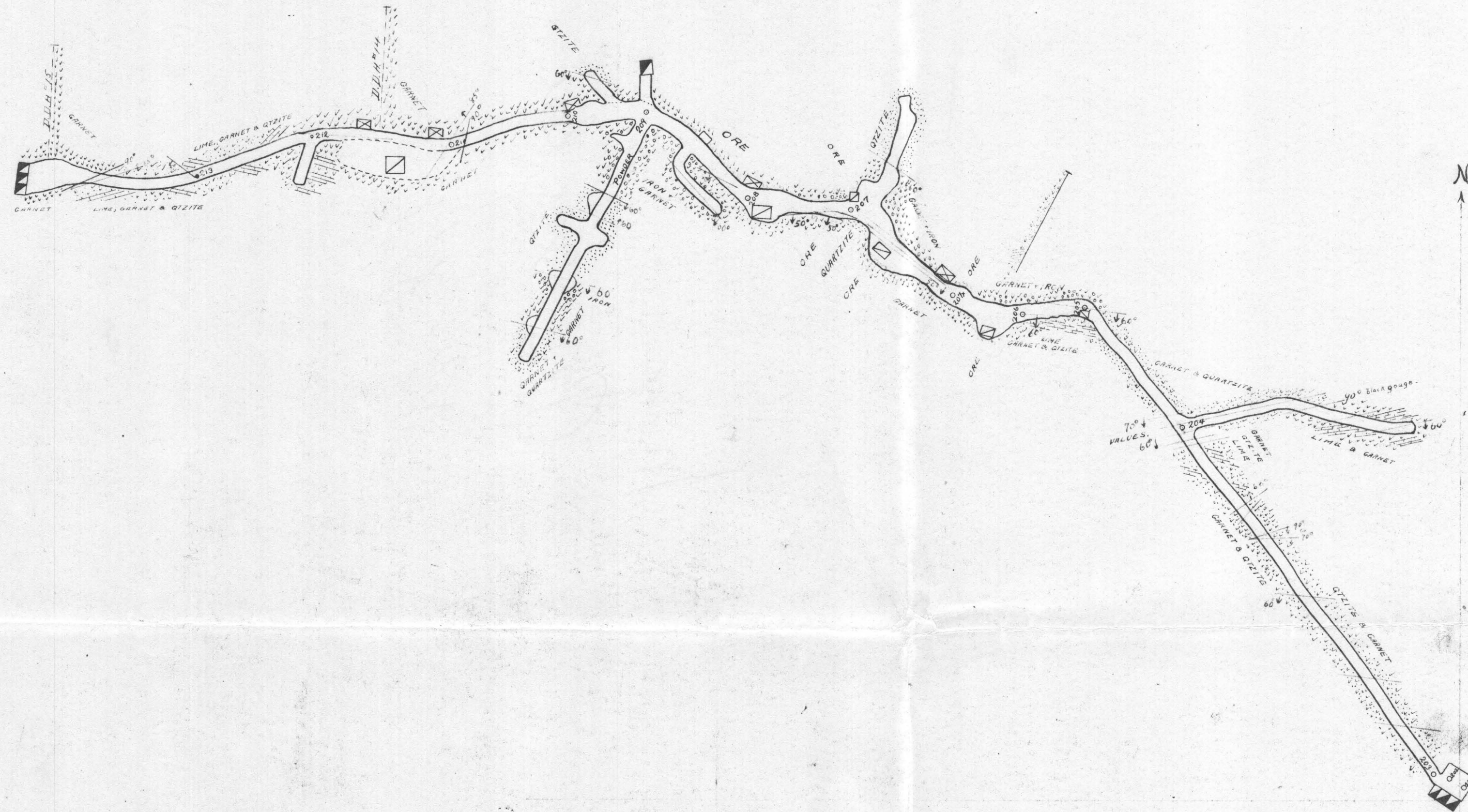

Plan of Long Island

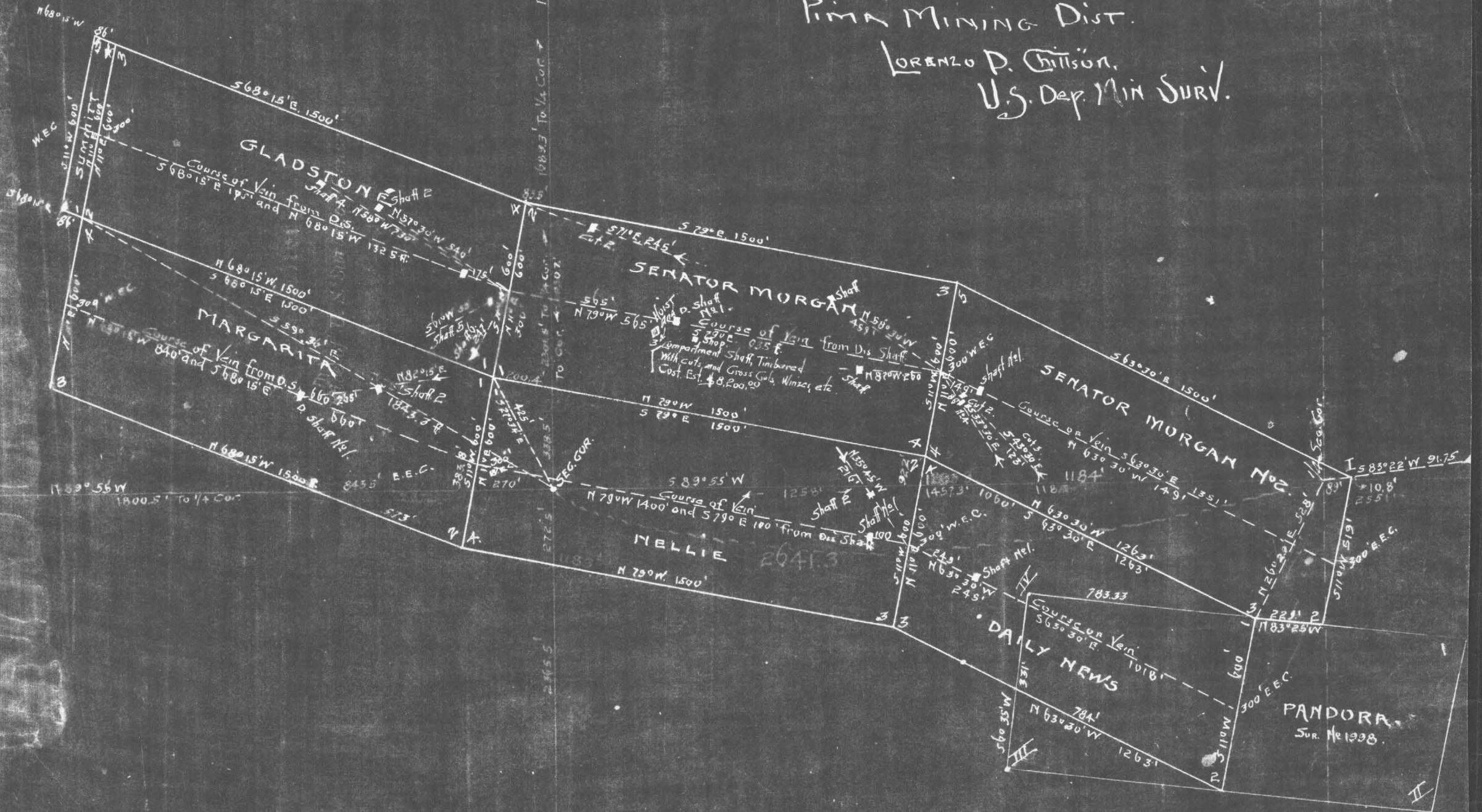

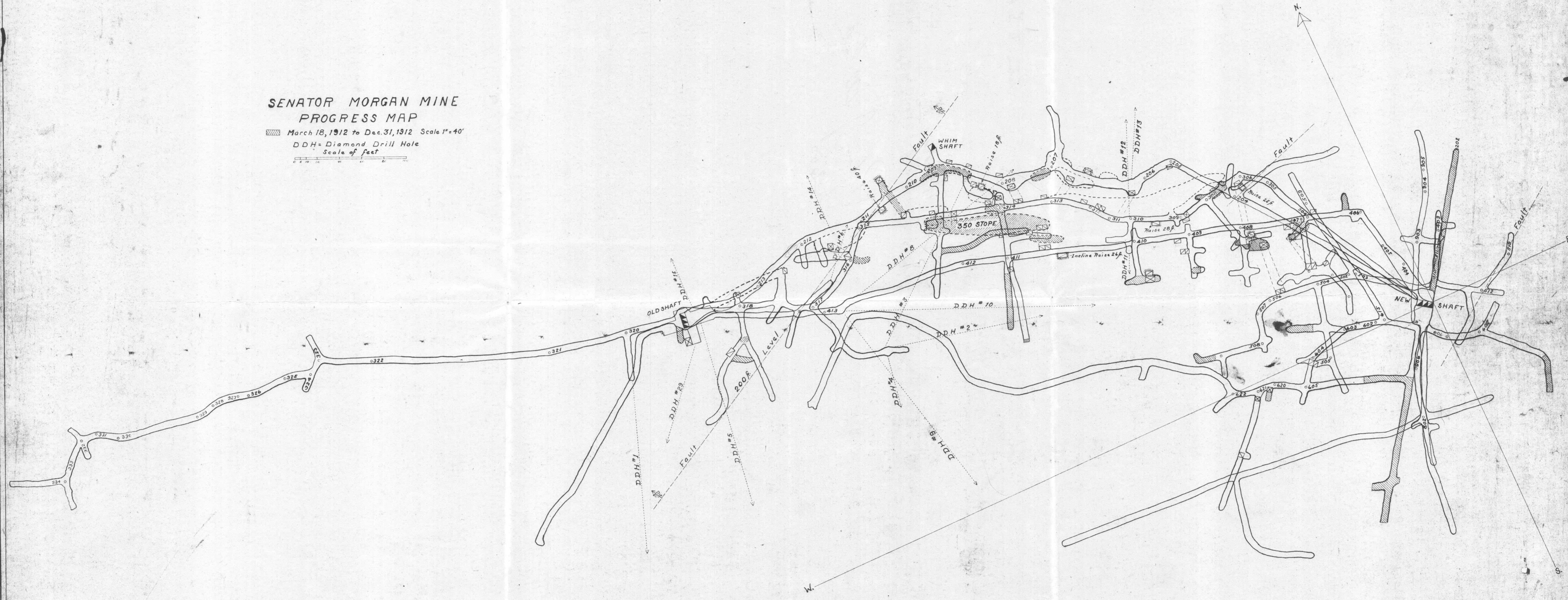
