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

Pacific Regional Operations, Inc., would like to conduct a preliminary geological evaluation of your mining property in the Wallapai District, Mohave County, Arizona.

If this proposal is agreeable to you, please so indicate by signing the enclosed Affidavit of Ingress and Egress which enables our geological staff to enter the property for the preliminary evaluation. 
