
In accordance with our telephone conversation of last week, I am enclosing herewith some documentation regarding the subject mining claims. There are five adjoining claims: Walter Soroka, Walter Soroka, Jr.; Carlson Mines I and II, and the Lucy Mine. I enclose Maps of each of the claims and Notices of Mining Claim Location on two. (I don't have copies of everything here with me at this time). On the Carlson Mines, these maps have just been prepared for Linda Carlson, who did not correctly show her diagrams on a recent refileing, so this is being done to amend her claims. On the Lucy Mine, this was a new claim filed with BLM subsequent to the Exxon lode claim in that area. This is one that was personally given to me. I need to go to the BLM to see the validity of this claim. The other four claims date back to 1970. In discussing these claims with Ken Phillips at the Arizona Mineral Museum, he stated that the Soroka claims appear to be in good order, the Carlson claims need some clarification.

I also enclose copies of some assay and spectrographic reports on these claims. I have Affidavits of Labor on the Soroka mines from 1971 through 1980, but I enclose just one of 1971 and one for 1980. If you needed to see the rest, I can supply them to you. Ms. Carlson has written to the Yavapai County Recorder's for copies of her Affidavits of Labor, and is obtaining additional copies of other assay reports on her claims, which I can supply to you at a later date, if required.

I also enclose, as a further description of these claims, a copy of a form letter I have used in contacting mining companies to promote the mining of these claims.

I thank you for your interest and would appreciate your comments and any information you can supply regarding these claims. Should you require any additional information or documentation, please let me know.
