TRANSCRIBED DIARY ENTRIES.

Dec. 15

- O630 PD man denied us entry by force. He had a gun and threatened us if we proceeded to planned drill pad. Communication by radio from Grover--the PD (?) man said, "I have a gun and I know how to use it."
- 0643 Guard ordered the rig not to raise the mast.
- O705 Second PD truck arrives at hilltop pad. Guard, named "Hank" walks uphill, fires pistol once into air. Second truck comes down hill, and a second guard gets out. Both vehicles blue pickup trucks.
- O708 Guard, Hank Briggs, and second man, Clifford Willis, of O.B. Willis Co., order rig off property by order of Phelps Dodge Co.
- 0712 Guards depart. Started engine of rig for purpose of raising mast.
- * 0715 LATE ENTRY- Mast raised.
 - White Dodge pickup arrives at rig, man gets out and approaches group. Man is Bill Bowen, PD geologist, who wants to make sure we know that we are on Tract 37. We assure him we are aware of that fact. He then informs us of the existence of claim "Scorpion" which he says exists between Tract 37 and Essex claim "D&L."
 - Pale green pickup approaches, man gets out and proceeds to rig. Man is Skip Clark, Manager of PD operation, says he is moving a dozer in.
 - 0745 Bull dozer and blue Ford pickup approaching
 - 0750 Paul Eimon and Howard Lanier arrive.
 - Bill Bowen, Skip Clark, Cliff Willis and one other ordered us off the property under threat of bringing dozer and front end loader down and give one warning and shove rig into creek. In order to avoid damage to equipment, we are pulling back. Most was lowered.
 - O815 Clark Hirshi of Boyles arrived to say that at 7:40 he was called by phone by Bill Browen who threatened to destroy the Boyles drill rig unless he ordered it off PD property.

Essex then moved drill rig to KIM 1 on the North of the Burm. As the drill mast was raising, Bill Bowen, Cliff Willis and others began walking to the Essex drill ahead of a PD dozer advancing with blade down.

Bowen identified himself as a PD agent and said the drill must be moved behind the burn in 15 minutes or he would order the dozer operator to push the rig into the wash.

He then informed P. I. Eimon, Ken Jones and E. G. H. that the land in dispute (Tract 37) was part of the exchange and as PD agent he was ordering us off. He said PD had old mineral rights and was exchanging this property. He stated "We claim mineral ownership of this ground now." He refused to say the burm was the boundary to Tract 37. Time 8:30

Bill Bowen stated that the Kim 2 was not located yesterday and he further advised that we (Essex) should not explore the Scorpian.
