Gentlemen:

The enclosed copy of the Plat covering 23 Patented Mining Claims, owned equally by the undersigned, Chris G. Muller and Mabel S. Thompson, is submitted to you for your consideration.

The property is located in the Plomosa Mining District of Yuma County Arizona and was patented by D. and D. Land Company in 1915 so all the workings shown were prior to that time. It is our understanding that ores other than copper were mined by this Company.

Since our ownership, a small amount of open pit mining of oxides has been done on Claim #10. We used this ore for leaching and recovered the copper, in the form of cathodes, with an electrolytic plant located on a 40 acre property approximately 8 miles north of the claims near U. S. Highway 60.

Within the past year a member of your firm's Tucson office visited Mr. Muller and expressed an interest in the property. For your information, the property is now open for option and we would appreciate a reply as to your possible interest in it at the present time. We feel that the Claims have a good potential for development into a good mining property and are desirous of your firm investigating the property with a view to entering into an exploration option to purchase agreement to that end.

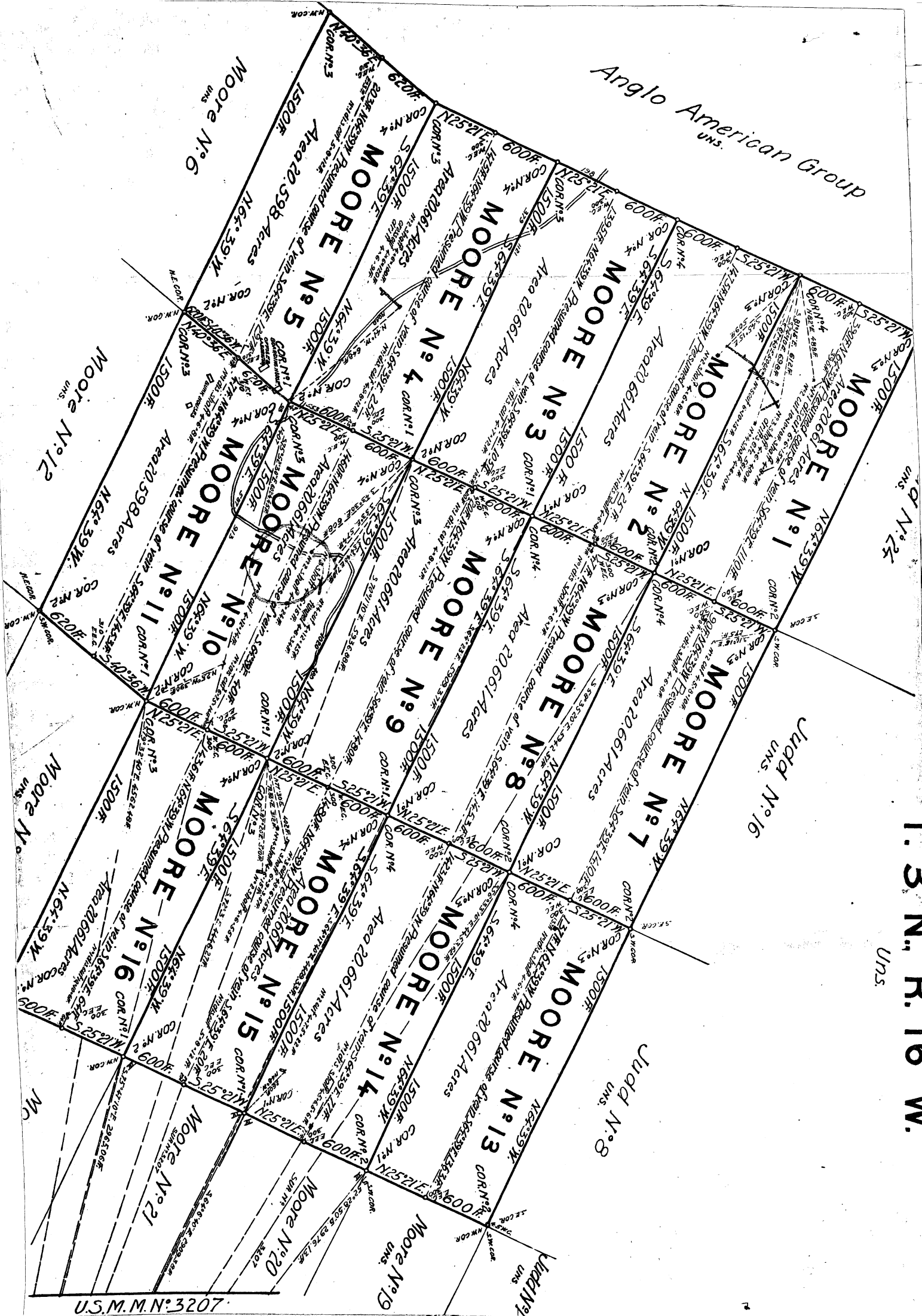
