Ti Inc. has located 770 claims east of Powderhorn. These claims were probably located for uranium prospecting. North east of Powderhorn there is a circular basin cut in altered rock that is crossed by the highway. There appear to be three porphyry plugs in the basin, with no mineralization. Veins radiating from the basin are altered and mineralized.
