Duray County

Bear-Moore Corp. controls in excess of 72 claims at Red Mountain, south of Duray. During the past two summers they have drilled one hole to a depth of 3000 feet. Reportedly the hole is favorable with considerable copper mineralization encountered. They plan to drill another hole next year. Part of this property is controlled by option from Baumgartner, who is willing to discuss future arrangements.

Idarado Mining Co. has located 120 claims over patented claims they own between Red Mountain and Teluside, apparently to protect their vein operations. This company is a subsidiary of Newmont Mining Co. and controls the west side of the alteration area at Red Mountain.

Bear Creek Mining Co. controls 32 claims at The Blowout, north of Duray.
