MINA - BANNER

In a meeting with Allan Bowman July 9, 1970, the Mina property in Hawthorne, Nevada was again discussed. Banner has approximately 5 square miles in this area which has a very strong oxide showing and has some indications of deeper reserves. They are currently drilling the property.

Bowman indicated his interest in our taking the property, here again with a possible position with Essex stock. Inasmuch as Bowman is very conservative regarding mining property evaluation, his indication of the oxide potential has considerable meaning. Therefore I am having Grover Heinrichs look at the property the next time he is in the Utah area. Bowman wants to be advised a week in advance.

Bowman also advised that their research group has devised a lime separating method which would be most valuable in treating high lime ores. Patent has been applied for, however he indicated willingness to review this with us at some appropriate time.
