1. Land status maps and claim ownership information was obtained for areas of exploration interest in San Bernardino County, California.

2. Mr. Glen L. Evans, Vice President Minerals Division, The Louisiana Land and Exploration Company, has responded to an inquiry.

There is a definite possibility at a later time that they would want to consider joint venturing the Copper Basin, San Bernardino County, California project and possibly some of the other areas they are working in the western states.

3. A review was made of geologic work in progress at the Milford Mine and projects to be undertaken during the remainder of the year discussed.

4. Negotiations on the Imperial Mine are continuing, with a first offer of free exploration time and a \$250,000.00 end price for World Comm.'s 70% interest being considered.

5. The G.S.A., Portland convention was attended. Papers were given on the geology of Western United States and Canada. An improved understanding of the geology and potential of these areas was obtained.


