During our telephone conversation last November 20, you brought to my attention the Dixie claims in western Maricopa County. I subsequently discussed the claims with Scott Hazen, who gave me a certain amount of geologic data thereon. Following Hazen's conversation, I made a brief air reconnaissance and in the absence of the typical coloration anomalies associated with porphyry-copper deposits, I did not examine the ground immediately.

However, our Mr. See made a field reconnaissance on the ground recently, and he concluded that the mineralization is not indicative of a widespread copper zone amenable to open-pit mining.

Accordingly, this letter will serve to advise you that we will take no further action with respect to this property.

Dear Mr. Sanders:

This acknowledges your letter and enclosures received October 13, 1970, concerning the Yaeger copper mine and the Dixie prospect.

I am doubtful that the Yaeger mine would fit well with Kaiser's objectives, due to the narrowness of the vein and the probability that the best ore may be further restricted to individual shoots within the vein. However, I will review the assay plan of the mine workings before reaching a final decision on this matter.

With respect to the Dixie prospect, I have been in this general vicinity and am doubtful that a large tonnage copper deposit exists in that area. However, I have a general interest in silver exploration in Western Arizona, and from my previous notes of that region, consider it worthwhile to examine it some time in the future. The Dixie group would be included as part of a regional reconnaissance of general nature, and for my further information I would appreciate a precise location of the claims, and directions which would guide me to them. Mr. Higbie's report gives nothing but a vague location.

I wish to thank you for bringing these prospects to our attention, and I will let you know our interest concerning the Yaeger mine as soon as possible, and I will await additional information on the Dixie prospect.




