


DOME ROCK PROPERTY
LA PAZ COUNTY, ARIZONA

The 278 MCL lode and other lode and placer claims plus 8 leased placer claims are in the Dome Rock Mountains just west of Quartzite. The leased placer claims are all within the same lease agreement with a payment due on March 1, 1991. The claims are just north of Interstate 10 and are accessed from the Dome Rock interchange. Bedrock is generally Precambrian gneisses and schists, and there are younger diorite and quartz monzonite intrusive rocks. The area shows a very strong north 30 west structural fabric. Initial interest in the project was generated by the presence of placer gold workings in some of the gullies. An unsuccessful attempt was made to conduct placer operations on the property. A very preliminary mapping and sampling program was initiated by Meyer, and some zones with quite high gold values were located. Samples from the southwest area of the project, Silica Ridge, contained 0.04 - 0.07 oz Au/ton, and one copper-bearing vein contained 0.495 oz Au/ton. The Silica Ridge area is a silicified zone occurring between schist and diorite. Nine RC holes were drilled on the property, and holes 90-1 through 90-6 tested the Silica Ridge zone. Significant gold values were not found in the drill holes. Holes 90-7,8, and 9 were in strongly altered rock which contained gold values in the 0.00X range.
